Symposium on G-20: Connecting young India towards inclusive and action oriented goals

The Geography department of Kalindi College, University of Delhi organized 'Symposium on G-20: Connecting young India towards inclusive and action oriented goals' on 4th September 2023. For the symposium event, two speakers were invited Prof. Praveen Kumar Pathak (Professor, JNU) and Dr Ankur Yadav, (Assistant Professor, JNU) to encourage and inspire the audience. Prof. Praveen Kumar Pathak initiated his speech on the topic India's G-20 Presidency and Pathways to Atmanirbhar Bharat by introducing the theme of G20. He talked about evolution and how young minds reshape stereotypes. His innovative instances highlight the message in the storylines such the Technological evolvement, Reliance accomplishments, Post Covid remarks, ISRO's success. He also addressed the need for self-development and risk taking, the issues of gender equality, availability of resources as well as management of available resources.


