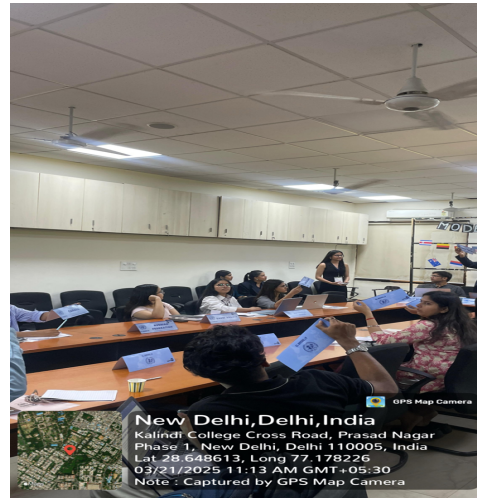

The flagship annual fest of KaCES, "Arthasaar," featured four exhilarating competitions:

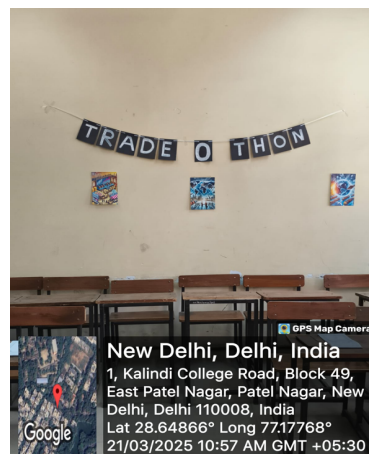
- **Model ILO:** A simulation of the International Labour Organization.
