Detailed Report:

On 7th February 2026, Swargunjan Music Society, hosted a workshop on **“The Implications of Artificial Intelligence in Music”**. This workshop was led by **Mr. Saurabh Kumar** who is a music producer, audio engineer, and an educator.

The workshop started with the traditional lamp lightening ceremony and the guest was then felicitated by the Convenor of the society Mrs. Anuradha Kotiyal.

A workshop was conducted to shed light on the evolving role of Artificial Intelligence in the field of music. The speaker effectively demystified the concept of AI, discussing its advantages, limitations, and ethical considerations in creative practices. Special emphasis was laid on the responsible and ethical use of AI technologies in music production.

During the session, the speaker showcased various AI-assisted tools for music composition and audio-visual creation, including platforms such as SUNO.AI. Rather than promoting blind dependence on generative AI, the speaker critically addressed its implications and cautioned against its misuse. A key highlight of the workshop was the emphasis on collaboration over replacement, stressing that AI should be viewed as a supportive tool that enhances human creativity rather than substituting it.

The session also explored important legal and ethical gray areas such as copyright, plagiarism, and proper attribution, making students aware of the responsibilities that come with using AI-generated content. Participants were encouraged to adopt AI as an ally and not perceive it as a threat to creative professions.

The workshop concluded with an interactive Question and Answer session, where students actively engaged with the speaker to clarify doubts and share perspectives. The event formally ended with a vote of thanks delivered by the Convenor Anuradha Kotiyal. Overall, the session was highly engaging, informative, and provided valuable insights into the thoughtful integration of AI in music and creative fields.
