History of Buddhism in Kashmir - Gandhara; with special reference to Archaeological evidence: When						

the image of Buddha was introduced in Gāndhāra for the first time in early Kusāna (Kushana) period, his followers in Gāndhāra and entire north-western region of the sub-continent had been intimately in touch with the Hellenistic civilization, and had been greatly impressed by it. However, vihāras or monasteries assumed a prominence among all the institutions of the state and monks a unique class distinction. The people, who were already imbibing awe and inspiration from sculpture stories of Buddha's life, must have been quite happy to see a personification of the lord (Buddha) in the full Olympian grace and dignity. Beyond any doubt, these statues found their way immediately to all the monasteries and shrines of the Buddhist world. It has now clearly been proved that it was in the north-western part of the Indian-sub continent (Gāndhāra), that this unique artistic revolution took place.
