Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. was a great leader. He impired many people. He brought about changes that are important to everyone in the United States. In

fact, he is known around the world and was also awarded the Nobel Peace Prize. He did not believe in segregation, but in unity. He advocated change through peaceful methods because he did not think that violence ever won any long-lasting peace.

Dr. King launched protests through non-violent methodology, organizing civil rights agitations. When he led marches, people were angry, but he remained determined. Even though people kept shouting him down, he kept marching. African-Americans who were afraid to stand up to oppression by White people were encouraged by his example. They started marching with him. Together they would overcome, he promised. Soon, thousands joined his campaigns. He organized boycotts. A boycott means people refuse to shop at a certain place, buy a certain type of product, or avail a specific service. The boycott that Dr. King led was called the Montgomery Bus Boycott. Before the boycott, in 1955, African- Americans could not ride in the front of buses. They had to take seats or stand at the back even if there were available seats at the front of the bus as only the White people could occupy

those seats. The boycott took months but was ultimately successful. They could then sit anywhere on the bus that they wished!

Dr. King was a prolific writer and made passionate speeches that roused his audience. One of his most famous speeches was delivered in Washington DC and is referred to as the iconic "I have a Dream" speech. In it, he urged African-Americans to step forth and take the promise of equality that had been offered in the Constitution of America by the Founding Fathers. Today, the United States celebrates his life with a special holiday every year. Even though Martin Luther King was assassinated for the challenge that he posed and the ideologies that he propounded, his legacy has lived on.
