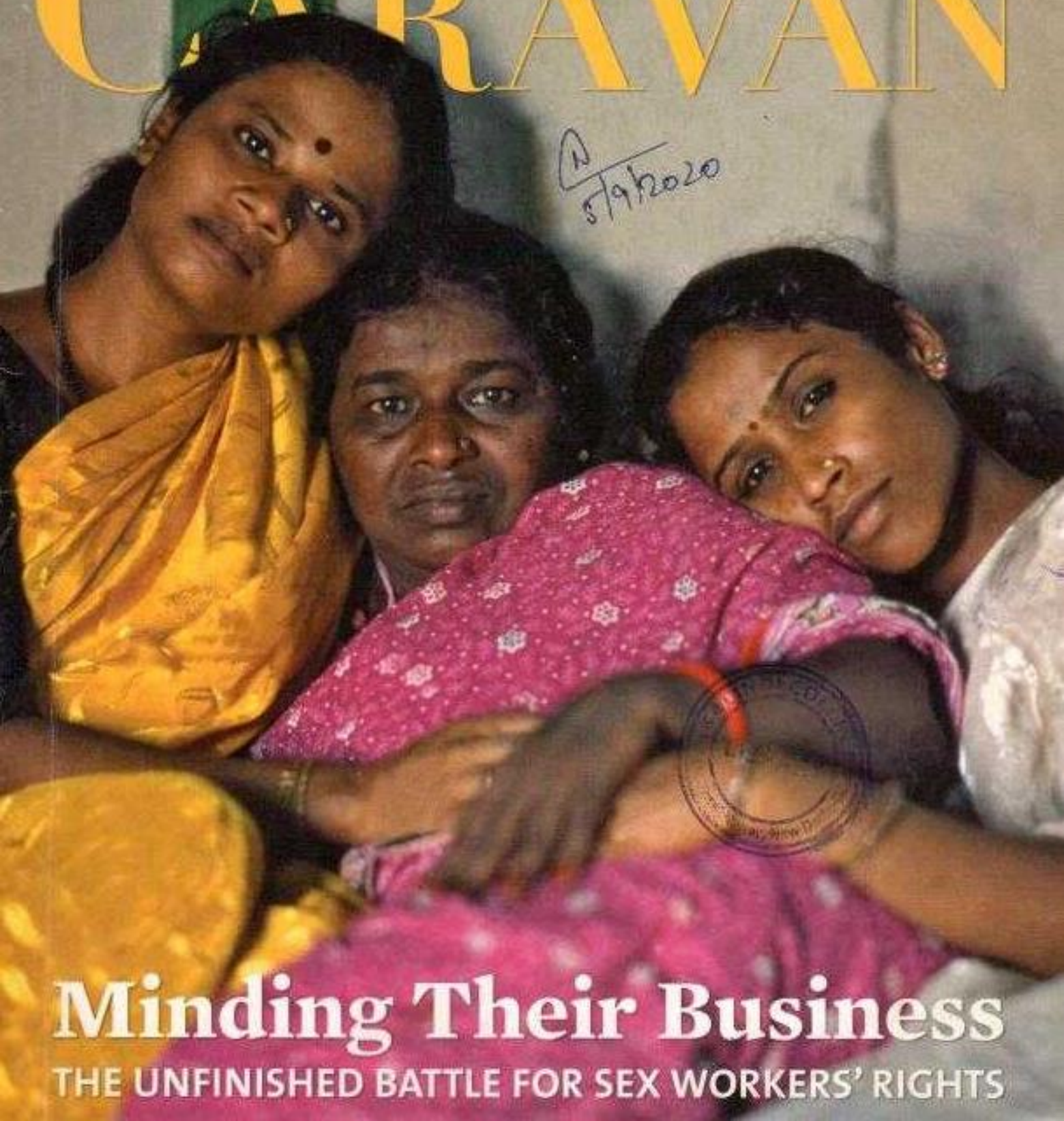

THE UNFINISHED BATTLE FOR SEX WORKERS' RIGHTS

In the 1990s, in far-flung parts of India, pioneering sex workers' collectives succeeded in reining in HIV, and soon expanded their missions to address the multitude of injustices inflicted on their members. Working together and speaking for themselves, sex workers began to catalyse once-unimaginable changes: transforming their work conditions and everyday circumstances, compelling the government to heed their well-being and even shaping global thinking about sex work. For a giddy moment, it seemed impossible to imagine a reversal. Yet that, tragically, is what soon followed – with the United States government, celebrity feminists, and Christian and Hindutva obscurantists joining hands to blight the sex workers' movement, and to imprison countless sex workers in the name of rescuing them.
