ONLINE DONATION DRIVE 2020



DEBATE COMPETITION


An online Intra-College Debate

The event ended with all participants understanding the importance of no discrimination.






OPEN - MIC COMPETITION



REPORT ON CONTENT HELPLINE KALINDI COLLEGE, DUIN ASSOCIATION WITH KRANTII: SWAASTH

The NSS Unit is working with Zoological society and Kranti: Swaasth from 15 april, 2021.

Around 25-30 NSS volunteers are working to fight against covid-19. We started a initiative with connecting people having Covid related medical and plasma requirement with donors and other verified source available.

At first, we started verifying all the information we have regarding plasma donors, medicines ,injections, beds and oxygen cylinder.

After getting a list of verified information for various requirements , we created google form links for patient requirements.

After getting request from the patients we started them to connect with the verified information. We got a great support from the members of Kranti group. We shared the google forms on various social sites. After collecting enough data we shared the verified information with everyone by providing the links for verified resources as it helps the patient to search the verified information of their need. After few days the student union team also started working with us for helping the Covid patients. In addition to plasma and medical requirement we shared information of meals for Covid patients, medical assistance and ambulance services.
