

Pant (Professor of International Relations, Department of Defence Studies, King's College London, United Kingdom), Dr. Veena Kukreja (Head of Political Science Department, University of Delhi), Dr. Nivedita Giri, Dr. Priyabala Singh, Dr. Manila Narzary along with other faculty members and student researchers of Universities of India and abroad.

On the topic "India's Foreign Policy: New Directions" both the guest speakers gave insights upon India's foreign policy which envisages to widen its sphere of influence, enhances its role across nations, and makes its presence felt like an emerging superpower. They also explained how the year 2021 presents a bunch of challenges and opportunities for India, in pursuit of fulfilling foreign policy objectives. For instance, the rise of China and its influence in India's neighborhood is a cause of worry for India and it's foreign policy decisions. The speakers also threw light on the fact that, "In shifting the balance of power in the South Asian region, India needs to tackle foreign policy challenges and leverage opportunities carefully."

On 18 February 2021, Politeia organized 2nd International Webinar which was accompanied by Prof. Daniel S. Markey, (Senior Research Professor in International Relations, John Hopkins University, Washington DC, USA) and students from all over India along with the Faculty Members. He was called upon to speak on the Topic "China and Geopolitics of South Asia".

In his speech, Prof. Markey gave an overview on, "How China's behavior has changed and how it has shifted its attention from Eastern Horizon to Western one. He made the audience aware with the two ground realities i.e., Pakistan becoming a major part of China's foreign policy, and India & Pakistan's conflict will not be going to resolve in next ten decades. He also discussed India-China changing relationship in recent years and Emerging of China as a dominant external economic player across the South Asian region. In the end, the floor was open for the questions from the audience, which were answered by Prof. Markey in a very generous way.

International Webinar on Iran's Nuclear Energy

On 5th March, 2021 at 4:00 PM, Politeia has earnestly organized 3rd webinar of its International series on Contemporary Global Issues on virtual platform - Microsoft Teams.

Prof. Charles Freilich, (Department of Political Science, Tel Aviv University, Israel and Columbia University, New York, USA) joined the webinar as the Guest Speaker on the topic "Iran's Nuclear Program". He, firstly, explained that the Iranian interest in nuclear technology is not new and dates back to the 1950s. He also expounded how the American security system is developing in the Middle East to contain Iranian military activities & how it is becoming the major threat to the Iranian regime. Along with this he elucidated the factors behind growing Iranian nuclear power. Lastly, he ended his talk by untangling the consequences of Iran's nuclear program for the Middle East and international community. Also, explained how nuclear terrorism is emerging as the biggest and the most dangerous consequence of it. The remarkable session became interactional with the O/A.

International Webinar on Africa in an Emerging World On 10th March 2021, Politeia, Department of Political Science, Kalindi College organized its 4th International webinar on "Africa in the Emerging World Order" was accompanied by Prof. Stig Jarle Hansen, (Head of International Relations Program, Norwegian University of Life sciences, Akershus, Norway) as the Guest Speaker. The event was embellished with the presence of Dr. Nivedita Giri, Dr. Priyabala Singh & Dr. Manila Narzary along with faculty members,

researchers and students from various universities as participants.

Prof. Hansen elucidated the fact that Africa is the world's second-largest continent both in terms of land & population. He precisely mentioned, how Africa has the opportunity to reshape the world, how its economy is impressively emerging, and how Covid- 19 has changed the picture for it. He also comprehended the importance of the river Nile, in the growth & development of Africa. Through PPT, Professor justified the point that Africa will be in more profit if it is befriended with America rather than China. He concluded his speech by giving insights upon the emerging interests of foreign actors in Africa like – Turkey, UAE, Qatar, Russia, & EU.

International Webinar on Demystifying the Belt and Road Initiative

Politeia organized its 5th Webinar of International Series on the topic, "Demystifying The Belt and Road initiative " on 12 March 2021 and received Prof. Rafiq Dossani (Director, Center for Asia Pacific Policy, Professor, Pardee Rand, Graduate School, Rand Corporation, California, USA) as Guest Speaker. The session began at 4:30 PM through a virtual platform- Microsoft Teams, with the presence of Dr. Nivedita Giri, Dr. Priyabala Singh, and Dr. Manila Narzary along with faculty members & students of various Indian & Foreign Universities.

Prof. Dossani highlighted that the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) is the world's largest development finance initiative whose founder is China, and also invested more than 80 billion US\$ in 70 participating countries since its launch. Moreover, he delineated the fact that China is not provided the finances for the development projects but also aided its building by state-owned Chinese firms which also differentiate this initiative from other typical foreign aid initiatives. He explained the importance of this initiative by stating that BRI focuses not only on achieving global connectivity with China, but also helps in meeting the need for infrastructure at national levels. He also gave some examples - Pakistan Economic Corridor, Mombasa - Nairobi Standard Gauge Railway, etc. Lastly, by discussing the public policy issues of the BRI initiative, he unfolded the gains of China and the host country and thereby, concluded his lecture by quoting, "Infrastructure is the key to long term development".

International Webinar on Politics and Religion in Middle East

On 18th March 2021, Politeia had organized its 6th International Webinar on Global Contemporary Issues and Prof. Hassan Abbas, (Distinguished Professor of International Relations, Near East South Asia Centre for Strategic Studies, National Defense University, Washington, DC, USA), joined as the speaker of the day and delivered a lecture on "Politics & Religion in the Middle East Today: Policy Implications for the Biden Administration."

Prof. Abbas firstly settled the stage with a brief introduction of the topic in which he discussed the Impact of Covid-19, the current Energy Crisis, and its impact on the economy on Middle East. Further, Prof. Abbas illustrated the fact that the Middle East has a vast, complicated yet glorified history unfolded various reasons which paved the way for the religious influence in the politics of the Middle East. Out of which Islamic revolution, proxy wars between the countries, combating terrorism are the most important one. With this he sketched out the motivating factors behind the interest of USA in Middle East, for example, maintaining the free flow of energy, countering terrorist organizations, etc. Lastly, he talked about the USA administrative policies, under the leadership of two Presidents of the USA - Donald Trump and Joe Biden.

International Webinar on Leveraging Soft Power to Realize National Interests

On 26th March 2021, Politeia had organized its 7th webinar of the International Webinar Series, on the Topic "Leveraging Soft Power to Realize National Interest: Reflections on India's Foreign Policy Since Independence". Prof. Debidatta Aurobinda Mahapatra, (Director, Mahatma Gandhi Centre, Hindu University of America, Florida, USA) was the Guest Speaker. The event started at 4:30 PM on Microsoft Teams, with the presence of Dr. Naina Hasija, (Principal), Dr. Nivedita Giri, Dr. Priyabala Singh, and the TIC Dr. Manila Narzary along with more than 145 participants. While announcing the lecture, Prof. Mahapatra kept his focus on 3 major areas i.e., What are soft power and cultural diplomacy?; What are India's soft power assets?; and India's soft power and cultural diplomacy in action. He delineated the fact that "Soft power alone won't suffice, but its combination with hard power would galvanize India's rise as a global power".

A Workshop on Digital Citizenship and Civic Participation for Gender Equality

On the topic "Digital Citizenship & Civic Participation for Gender Equality", Politeia, Department of Political Science, Kalindi College, in collaboration with Centre For Social Research (CSR) and Twitter India had organized a Workshop on March 30, 2021, with the renowned Indian Journalist Ms. Faye D'Souza. The workshop was organized to empower young women in their engagement in the civic dialogue on social media and also influence policy development on issues of digital gender equality.

With Faye, 125 plus participants joined the event. The event was also live on YouTube and other social media handles of CSR. The session was conducted by a representative of CSR. Firstly, they explicated the importance of getting online, the power of connecting, and women's participation & voice of change. Then, explained the basics of using Twitter, the security and safety of individuals on it. Lastly, by setting forth the Twitter rules, the host handed over the stage to the Guest Speaker Ms. Faye D'Souza and she shared her experience of using Twitter App. She also dealt with the question "using social media with the fear of getting trolled or targeted" and encouraged girls of Kalindi Colleg to get online and be the voice of change. In closing, CSR on their official Twitter page (CSRIndia) initiated the tweet chats to encourage the participants to give a kick start to their Tweeting journey.

The webinar was hosted by the Principal Dr. Naina Hasija, Dr. Nivedita Giri, Dr. Priyabala Singh and Dr. Manila Narzary. The webinar was a grand success with several Indian & Foreign participants.

Firstly, Prof. Swaran Singh led the session by his opening remark on multiple ways of linking & building strategy of East Asia in which he listed the growth and development of countries like India & Japan. and their engagement with other Asian countries. 


