### **7.2b: Kerala relief fund Rally:**

Kalindi College, NSS Unit witnessed the best of humanitarian quintessence on August 31, 2018 with the organisation of a Rally and Drive for Relief of Kerala flood Victims covering the college campus covering surrounding areas via B L Kapoor Hospital and Rajendra Place Metro Station along with Social responsibility cell, Students' Union and NCC. The rally was beautified with the presence of Dr. Anula Maurya, Principal, Kalindi College along with the teaching and non-teaching staff, Kalindi College Students' Union, Social Responsibility Cell, RAQS- Dramatic Society of Kalindi College and the students from all the courses. It was evident to see the contribution and helping nature of commoners who contributed their bit so as to help the southern belt to replant their lives. NSS volunteers simultaneously collected funds from the complexes following the route of the rally.

The reflection of the idea of "Not Me, But You" certainly catches every eye and motivated the commoners. The second segment of the relief program included a collection drive by the NSS volunteers in the most crowded areas of Delhi including Rajouri Garden, Chandni Chowk, Daria Ganj, Tilak Nagar, Janakpuri, Pacific Mall, Subash Nagar, Tank Road, Patel Nagar, Connaught Place, Paharganj and Karol Bagh on 31<sup>st</sup> August and 1st September for the collection for funds and goods which can help Kerala overcome the disaster.
