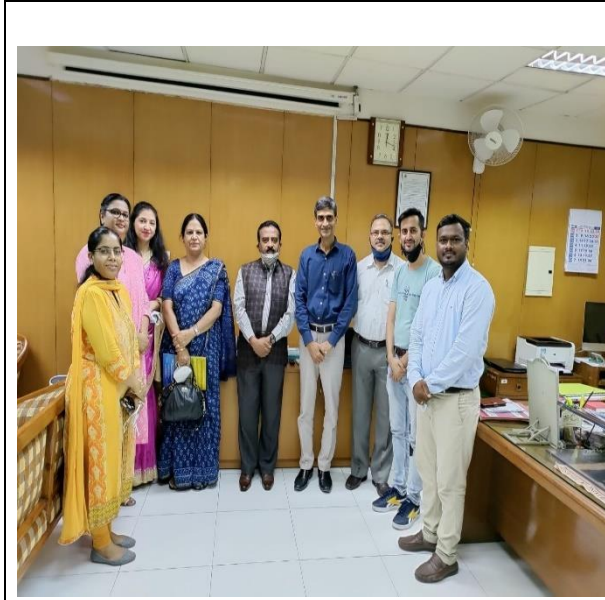

Report of previous activities of the Cell conducted in the year 2021

MoA between National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) & Kalindi College to enhance Student's entrepreneurial skills of self-employment

A Memorandum of Association, (MoA) was signed between National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) Technical Services Centre, Okhla Industrial Estate, New Delhi 110020 and Kalindi College, University of Delhi, New Delhi 110008 on *6 August, 2021*. This MOA shall remain effective for three years and may be extended by the parties on mutual agreement in writing. Also, both the parties mutually agreed upon revisiting the scope of the MoA as and when needed with a view to expand the scope of the same. The expertise provided by NTSC to Kalindi College, University of Delhi as consultancy, mentorship, expert lecture, etc. will be on payable as per mutually acceptable terms. Both the parties agreed to involve their duly authorized representatives to help achieve the set goals mentioned in MoA. The primary objective of this MOA is to enable the parties to identify mutual collaboration opportunities bringing together the strength of the NSIC and Kalindi College, University of Delhi toward sustained development of skills and education aimed at enhancement of self-employment and opportunities.



In-House Skill Development Workshop on Code Free Web Designing (1-7September,2021)

Entrepreneurship, Skill Development and Innovation Cell, Kalindi College, organized a week long “In-House Skill Development Workshop on Code Free Web Designing” from September 1 to 7, 2021. A total of 75 participants from a list of 208 registered participants successfully attended this workshop. The course content of the workshop was prepared by Ms. Bhawna Shishodia, a student of Kalindi College and was delivered on MOOC platform successfully.

Workshop included series of step-by-step protocol to design a website using tailor-made easy to follow tutorials. Setting up a website is a pivotal step in showcasing various products, ideas and establishing legitimate connections depending upon the needs of the projects undertaken. In this context, it was seen that students were able to create their own website (list enclosed). Furthermore, it was interesting to see the diversity of ideas which can be instrumental in polishing entrepreneurial skills of students. Such an activity shall act as a catalyst in preparing a skilled work force of students who can better prepare themselves for current competitive job markets. The entire workshop was designed in such a way that it was very flexible in nature where students could access course contents as per their convenient time.

Students spent on an average of an hour per day in accessing video lectures, notes and also attempted quizzes based on the video lectures. Students also discussed their doubts in the discussion forum section. At the end of the course, 35 students were able to successfully develop their websites.

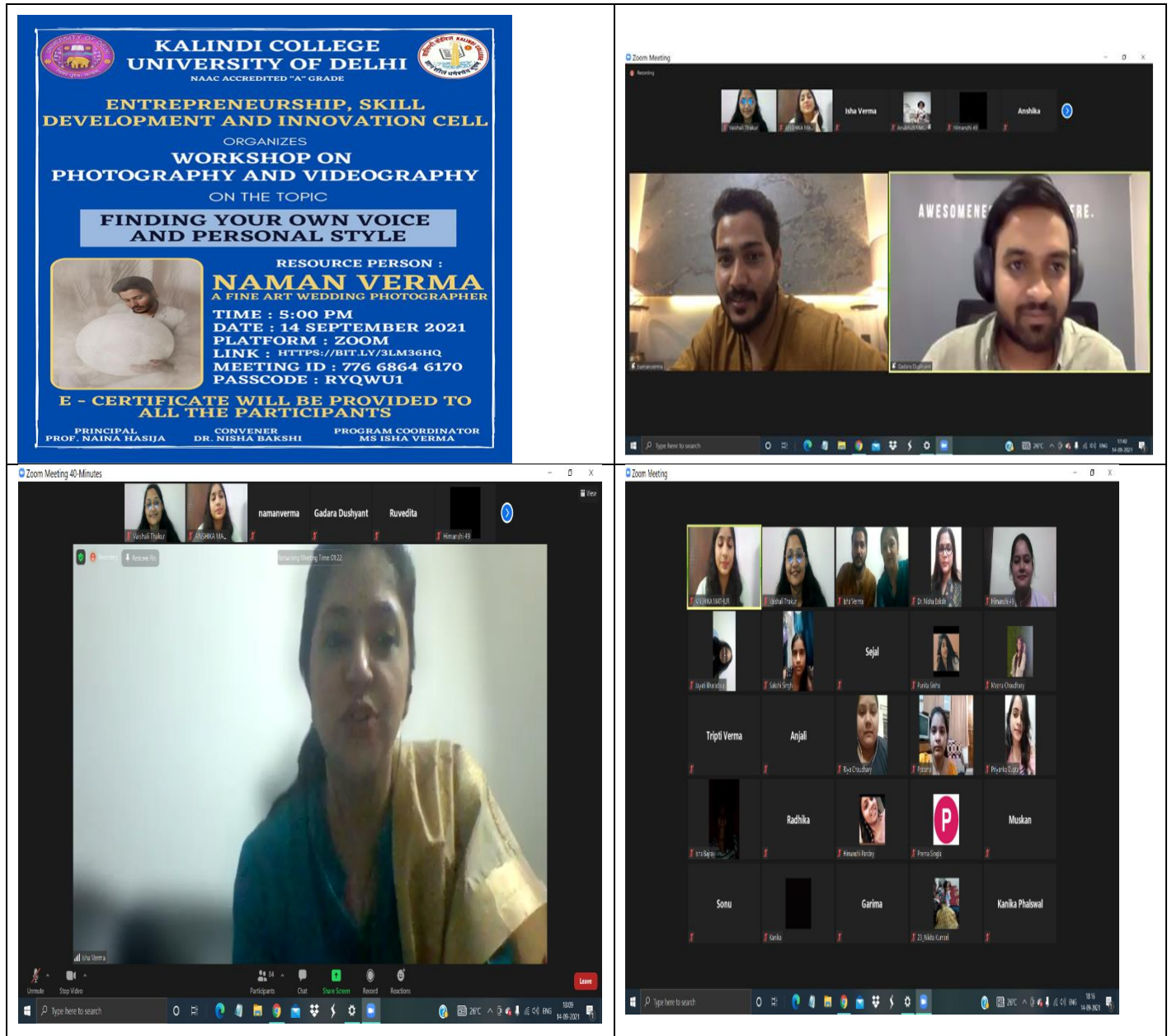


Workshop of videography and photography on topic “Finding your own voice and personal style”
