The director of SSS holds a meeting with his staff to discuss the organization's role and purpose to improve people's life in the community. He shared what he has learned at the conference. The SSS director explains that he will make it his personal mission to solve the problem of dual relationships and asks employees for their input and active participation in overcoming this obstacle to reform the organization in order to better serve the community.
