ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN BY KRYPTUS

KRYPTUS did not just offer bountiful opportunities to its students through placements and internships but also organized several interactive sessions without renowned speakers to enhance the knowledge of the students and help them sharpen their skills.

ORIENTATION SESSION

The Orientation session was conducted by the Placement Coordinators. Placement guidelines, processes and policies were thoroughly discussed along with the brochure and report of the previous academic year. Through the Q&A round, the Placement Council tried to answer all the queries of the students of the college.



WORK INTEGRATED LEARNING PROGRAM'22 (WILP) DATE: 28th September 2021

The event started with a brief introduction about Wipro Limited and it's transformation of Wipro from a small company to listing in the UK stock exchange and entering into BPO business. The speaker explained about the Work Integrated Learning Programme which provides students to work and study at the same time . She elaborated on the eligibility criteria and the selection process for the same along with stipend , online test and assessment criteria with a ppt . One of their employees also shared her experience about working in Wipro and M.tech courses . She talked about the training sessions , exposure to foreign clients and good working conditions at Wipro.

The event was witnessed by 13 students of Kalindi College.





Webinar on CV Writing in Collaboration with T.I.M.E. Date: 6th October, 2021

The session started with a general discussion about college and by defining the true meaning and purpose of a CV and differentiated it with a biodata. The speaker listed the characteristics of a CV i.e. should be brief, one page long, simple and formal. Further, the speaker talked about the statement of purpose (SOP) which will help in building an effective CV. She highlighted that a resume should be such that it catches HR's attention and should stand out from other resumes. The content of the resume should match the job profile. She stressed that the CV should be proofread and there should be no spelling or grammatical errors.

The speaker then explained the format of a CV in detail. She discussed every element of a CV and gave examples of common mistakes made by students while writing a CV. She emphasised writing about your true self, your hobbies, interests, activities and achievements. Moreover, she covered other points of importance such as plagiarism-free writing and LinkedIn networking. She concluded her speech by displaying the CVs of Elon Musk and Merrisa Mayers as an example.





Campus to Corporate Careers (C2C) Program by TechnoServe DATE: 3rd December 2021

The training was aimed for final year students and recent graduates by offering various programs like "Personal and Professional Effectiveness" to bring out the inner confidence, goals and passions while introducing them to key concepts in goal setting, financial planning and interpersonal skill development. The other program focused on "Communication Readiness" by introducing students to the basics in professional communication, communication dos' and don'ts as well as a comprehensive guide to giving interviews and group discussion. Various other programs were offered to students from commerce backgrounds which gives them the realities of the job markets. These programs helped to address the gap students' face while transitioning from campus to corporate as well as inculcating a sense of professionalism in them.

The enrolled students undergo assessments to map their current skills, workplace competencies and personality traits to provide them with a detailed analysis of their job readiness and enable a more targeted job search. The program has an ongoing career counselling component, where the students can seek guidance from experienced career counsellors on making appropriate career choices and coping with personal and professional pressures.




Financial Modelling Workshop DATE: 16 January 2022, Sunday

The resource person started the workshop with a case study of BOD Co. which is a franchise of Dr. Reddy pharmacy. He explained the pharmacy model question and gave a detailed explanation of some 'basics of Excel' which included representation and interpretation of columns, rows and cells. Further he showed how to do basic addition, subtraction, multiplication, rounding off and cell merge in Excel. He even explained the business applications in Excel like relevant and absolute referencing. The speaker also explained various concepts related to finance like balance sheet, debt, capital, sources of funds, investment, return, cash flow and profit. The practical application of these concepts were explained by giving real life examples. Various formulas used in excel were also discussed.

The workshop continued and the speaker explained to the audience about profit and cost calculation for any project or company. He made the session interesting by using diagrams while taking inputs from the participants. After explaining about Excel and concepts of finance, the resource person solved the entire case study using the techniques explained before.

The workshop was witnessed by a total of 74 attendees from Kalindi College.





PRE-PLACEMENT WORKSHOP-AIESEC

DATE: 22 January 2022, Saturday

The event started with a brief introduction to AIESEC by one of the team members, Niyati Mahajan. She shared how AIESEC works with the youth towards the fulfilment of their potential. She also shared the history of AIESEC which started in 1948 after the Second World War as a medium for international understanding to ensure the avoidance of similar conflicts in the future. They emphasised "youth" and "leadership" multiple times to iterate one of their goals as AIESEC was established – "for the youth and by the youth". Being young adults themselves, they set in place that the organisation works on a large level by college students. They also shared some of their values like 'striving for excellence, 'demonstrating integrity, and 'activating leadership'.

Thereafter, Niyati Mahajan explained the perks and benefits of joining AIESEC explaining how AIESEC is well recognized by the UN, and how "being involved here can provide you with an opportunity to be different and achieve what you want to achieve." She then shared the different departments of the organisation which are divided between front and back office. The front office deals with the outgoing and incoming global exchange. They called the back office the 'backbone of the organisation' with departments like, 'Business Development' and 'Finance and Legalities', 'People Management', 'Marketing', 'Customer Experience and Operations'. Furthermore, they shared their 'National Board of Advisory' with renowned names like Ronnie Screwala, founder of Upgrad, Arun Kumar, founder of KPMG, and UN advocate, Dia Mirza. Additionally, they provided details on the selection and enrollment process. The selection process will consist of three rounds:


<u>First round:</u> There'll be a group discussion on a basic topic where English speaking skills will be mainly tested.

The workshop was witnessed by a total of 96 attendees from Kalindi College.








FINANCIAL PLANNING WORKSHOP DATE: 22-23 January 2022

Only final year students were eligible to join the meeting and a total of 23 students joined.






PRE PLACEMENT TALK - LIMITLESS STREE DATE - 25th JANUARY 2022

The workshop was witnessed by a total of 46 attendees from Kalindi College.




ACCOUNT BASED DECISION MAKING WORKSHOP

DATE: 30th January, 2022 (Sunday)

The event started with a brief introduction about what would be taught in the session, that is Accounts and Decision Making, financial statement, along with a case study. To start the session, Maitreyi Agarwal, the Coordinator of Kryptus, welcomed everybody and the speaker, Mr. Adish Jain who's a CA (ended in 2016) and CFL (ended 2019) level 3. He has received a research analyst certificate from ISM. He also has 6+ years of experience from Morgan Stanley, and ICICI Securities along with 3+ years of experience in teaching strategic management, and taking training sessions on financial modeling. He is familiar with knowledge databases like Thomson One and DataStream. Thereafter, the resource person enlightened the participants that to make a financial statement is to 'understand and analyze a financial statement using theoretical and practical knowledge.' Further, he explained the concept of financial statements in terms of assets, liabilities, revenue, and equity capital. Before starting with the case study, he gave time to revise the concepts, articulate thoughts, and ask questions if any.

Afterwards, he introduced the case study of Asian Paints. He explained the balance sheet of Asian Paints and the associated relevant topics holistically like total operating revenue, EBITDA, EBIT, direct and indirect expenses, tangible and intangible goods, depreciation, amortization, etc. The audience was attentive and followed him step by step. The practical application of these concepts was explained by giving real-life examples. Further, he presented the ratios of Berger, a competitor to Asian Paints in India, to explain the importance of comparing one companies' ratio with its competitors to accurately analyze, including all the combined factors which company is better to invest in. He also said that the focus of introducing Berger was on the interpretation of the ratios and financial statements rather than just formulas.




Career Prospects in Mass Communication and Journalism DATE: 30th January, 2022 (Sunday)


Career Prospects in Political Science DATE: 8th February, 2022 (Monday)

All members of the committee put great efforts for the success of the program. It was a productive webinar for our students.






CAREER PROSPECTS IN DATA ANALYTICS






Career Options after BA Programme February 12th, 2022 (Saturday)




ETHICAL HACKING - PRO SCHOOL DATE - 13TH FEBRUARY 2022

At last Ritika Chandel casted a vote of thanks to Mr. Ramakrishnan on the behalf of The Placement Cell.






Possible Career Opportunities in Physics February 15th,2022 (Tuesday)
