This “Memorandum of Association” herein after referred to as MoA is signed on this day of 08 September, 2021 between the following two parties:

Centre for North East Studies, C 99 Ground Floor, East of Kailash, New Delhi- 110065. Centre for North East Studies is promoting research in the historical and holistic understanding of the northeast India by conducting seminars, lectures, research collaborations, primary research data collection and organizing cultural events as well as research publications.

And

Kalindi College, University of Delhi, East Patel Nagar, New Delhi, Delhi 110008, through its authorized representative, IBSD-Centre and Northeast Cell.

Each shall be referred to in this MoA individually as “party” or collectively as “parties”.


**A. Objective**

The primary objective of this MoA is to enable the parties to identify mutual collaboration opportunities bringing together the strength of both Centre for North East Studies and Kalindi College, University of Delhi towards promoting and understanding the northeast region in historical prospective.

**Areas of Collaboration**

Centre for North East Studies and Kalindi College, University of Delhi will collaborate in the following proposed areas:

1. To promote and organize webinar/seminar/lecture/talk on unsung heroes of northeast in history of Indian freedom struggle.
2. To connect students through promoting cultural activities.
3. To initiate visit to the Northeast region.
4. To promote collaborative research over historical understanding of northeast region.
5. To provide platform for internship of the Kalindi College students.

  
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## B. General Provisions

1. The parties agree that they shall use their best endeavors to execute the provisions of this MoA. As such this MoA is non-binding in nature and cannot be legally pursued.
2. None of these provisions of this MoA shall be deemed to constitute a partnership between the parties here and no party shall have any authority to bind the other or shall be deemed to be agent of the other in any manner. A detailed implementation plan may be drawn up annually by both the parties in this MoA.
3. This MoA shall become effective on and from the date of execution hereof and shall continue to be effective for one year. After this period, it may be extended by the parties on mutual agreement in writing until it is rescinded. This MoA may be terminated by either party by issuing a one-month prior written notice to the other party at any time during the validity of this MoA.
4. The MoA shall be revisited as and when needed by both the parties with a view to expand the scope of the same.
5. The expertise provided by Centre for North East Studies to Kalindi College, University of Delhi as consultancy, mentorship, expert lecture, etc. will be on payable as per mutually acceptable terms or it would be a volunteer basis.

***Event: "Exploring the Unexplored of Northeast India***

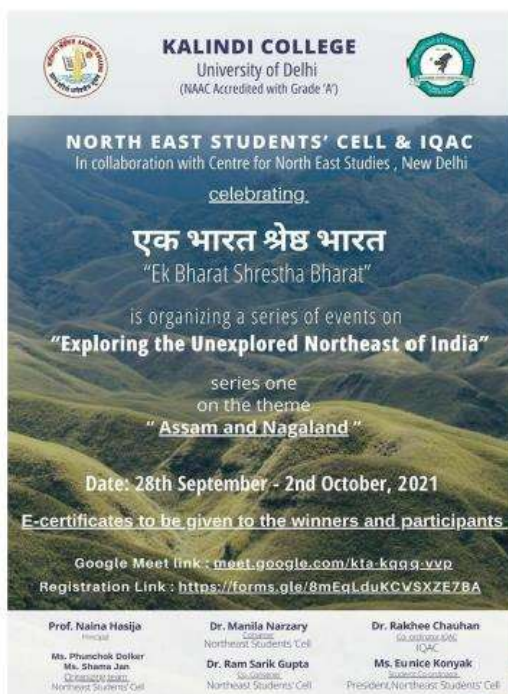
To Commemorate "Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat" and "Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav" in university spaces, The North East Students' Cell and Internal Quality Assessment Cell, of Kalindi college, University of Delhi, in Collaboration with Centre for North East Studies, New Delhi organized a webinar on "Exploring the Unexplored of Northeast India, on 28<sup>th</sup> Sep, 2021. The webinar was an attempt to recognize the unsung heroes of the Indian Freedom Movement in Northeast India. The webinar was the first of the series that is in the offing that would cover state-specific content and the introductory session provided insights on the subject from the perspective of Assam and Nagaland.

The session started with a beautiful Sattriya dance by Plabita Bhuyan, and was hosted and moderated by Ms. Phuncho Dolker, both members of the cell. It had as its chief guest, Dr. Rajdeep Roy, the Hon'ble Member of Parliament, Silchar, Assam. The keynote speaker was Dr. Raktim Patar, Assistant Professor in the Department of English, Gargaon College, Sivasagar, Assam. Webinar began with the welcome address by Principal Prof. Naina Hasija. Chief Guest Dr. Roy listed the northeast freedom fighters who contributed during India's freedom movement and also spoke of the ways in which history was misconstrued so that much of these figures were hauled into anonymity. By delineating the commonality of the history of independence struggle thus, he stressed on the need to insist on how "we are all one". Key Note speaker Dr. Patar began his lecture by emphasising the need to incorporate the Northeast into the larger imaginary of the nation and not as an isolated entity. Pointing out the freedom fighters in the Northeast, he talked about the Great Master Khasi, and the Garo Chiefs in Assam and also hinted at Subhash Chandra Bose, who he said, helped the Naga people from the

  
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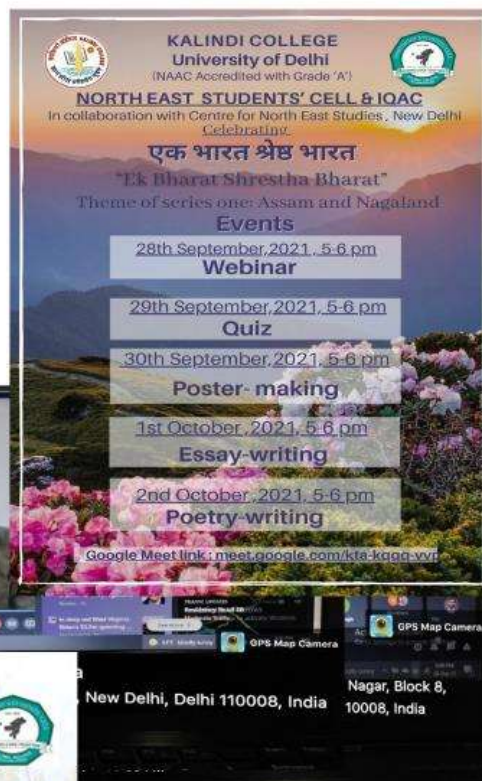


Japanese soldiers. The event was concluded by Dr. Manila Narzary, Convener of Northeast Students' Cell. Overall, the session left the participants with a collective sense of the need to read and pay attention to the nuances in history. History which, for most part becomes a narrative primarily through erasures and elisions of what is marginalized in the process of narrative building, to which Northeast was one instance.

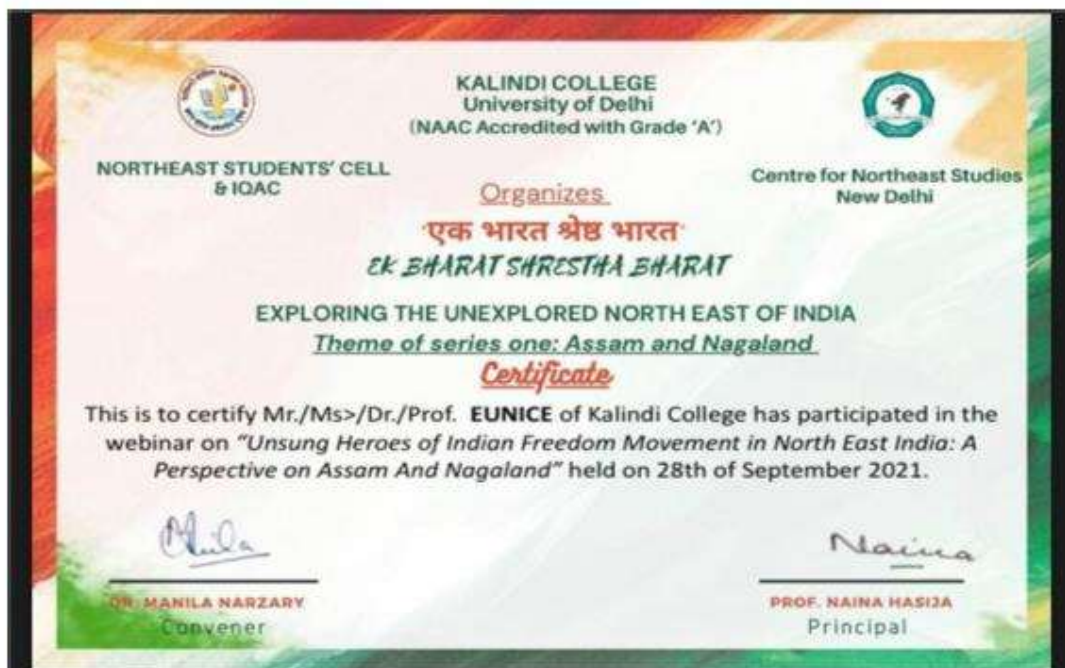

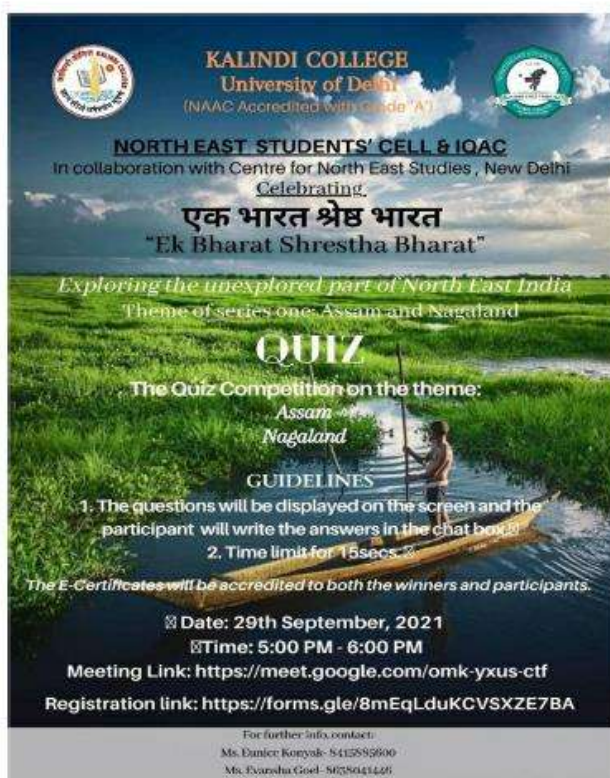
The compere of the event was Sangailiu Dangmei, 2<sup>nd</sup> year, English (Hon), she highlighted the theme of the program.

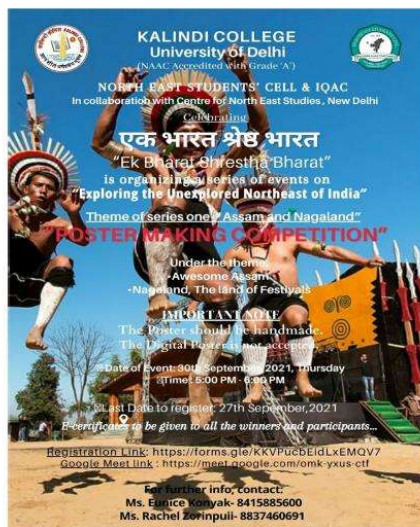

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The “MOOCs, E-Content Development, Research Methodology and Statistical Tools in Open Education World” a two week Faculty Development Programme (FDP) with the aim to attract and bring together experts, researchers and teachers to focus on connecting classroom teaching with applied research was organized by Kalindi College University of Delhi in collaboration with Mahatma Hansraj Faculty development Centre (MHFRDC). 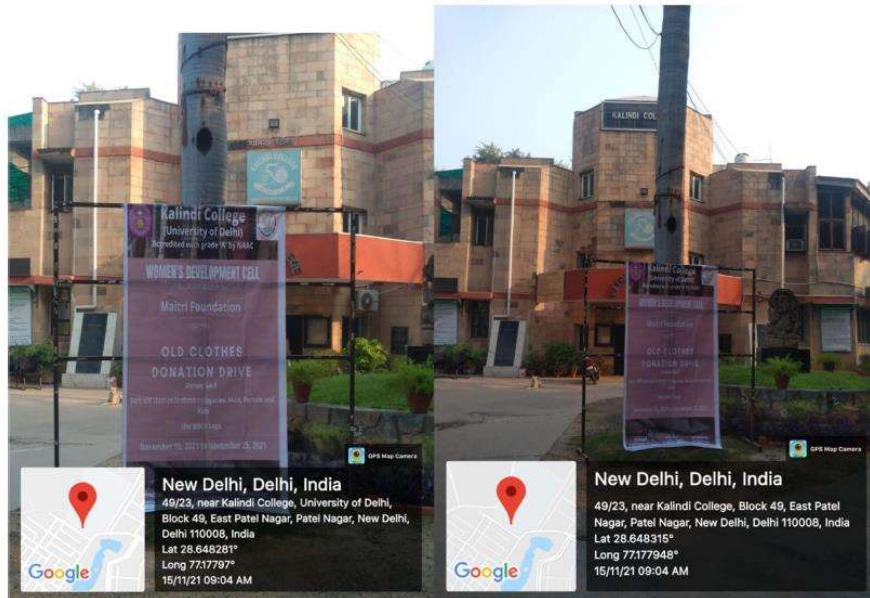

1. The Environment Pollution Analysis Lab (EPAL), Bhiwadi and Kalindi College, University of Delhi wish to collaborate in order to build capacity and benefit mutual research and teaching activities, and to further the internationalisation of both institutions. This collaboration aims to achieve high-level environmental contamination research outputs and to build the basis for continuing collaborative investment in scientific capability.

  - Joint publications in high impact international journals.
  - Joint supervision of PhD students.
  - Such other projects for mutual benefit that are agreed upon by both parties.
  - Enhancing linkages with potential end-users
4. Specific programs or activities will be undertaken under this MOU only after the written agreement of both institutions. The terms and conditions of each specific program or activity, including any financial arrangements, shall be set out in a separate written Agreement signed by an authorised representative of each institution.
5. Both parties shall designate a liaison officer for this MOU and for any subordinate agreements under this MOU. For EPAL, the officer shall be the Dr. Sudeep Shukla. For Kalindi College, the officer shall be **Prof. Naina Hasija**.

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6. Marketing and Publicity

  - a) The parties agree to share the surplus revenue generated by activities under the agreement, as applicable on a case by case basis.
8. Confidential Information
  - a) Each party agrees to treat as confidential all information designated as confidential or which by its nature is confidential or which is disclosed in circumstances importing an obligation of confidence that is obtained from the other party in connection with this MOU or activities undertaken pursuant to this MOU and not disclose such information except:
    - i. to such of the officers, employees and advisers of the party as have a legitimate interest in the confidential information to be disclosed to them;
    - ii. as may be required by applicable law (in which case, if permitted, prior to disclosure, the party must consult with the other parties about the form and content of such disclosure); or
    - iii. as the parties may agree in writing.
  - b) This clause 7 does not apply to information that is or becomes available in the public domain, is already lawfully known to the receiving party, or has been independently developed by the receiving party, other than as a result of a breach by a party of their confidentiality obligations.
9. This MOU comes into effect when it has been signed by both institutions on the date of the last signature. It will remain in effect for a period of 2 years from that date. Not less than six months prior to its expiry, the two institutions will review its operation and decide whether or not to renew it. Any such renewal shall be signed by an authorised representative of each institution, and may include variations to this MOU.
10. This MOU may be terminated by the written mutual consent of both institutions, or by either institution giving 60 days written notice to the other institution.
11. Except for clause 7, this MOU places no financial or legal obligations on either of the institutions, nor does it create any legal relationship between them.

3. Each training batch size will be between 30-50 students. Sessions of duration 1.5-2 hours duration will be conducted 5 days a week over a 2 – 2.5 month period at a time.
4. The program also includes individual student counselling, which will be conducted via online/offline platforms, as well as post training, pre-placement and post placement counselling.
5. Career fairs or individual placement drives will be conducted in an online/offline format to place trained students in formal sector jobs.
6. The above mentioned training and placement is free of cost for both, the students and college.

- B. The Client is desirous of engaging with NF for the purposes, and on terms, set forth herein.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:


### **3. Confidentiality**

The Parties agree that the expiry or any early termination of the Agreement shall be without prejudice to the rights of either Party in respect of any antecedent breach matter or thing.



8.2. In the event of any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, including any question regarding its existence, validity or termination ("Dispute"), shall initially be resolved by amicable negotiations among the senior executives of the Parties. If the Dispute is not resolved amicably within 10 (ten) days after receipt by one Party of the other Party's written request, the Dispute shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, as amended from time to time.

8.3. The arbitral tribunal shall consist of a sole arbitrator to be appointed with the mutual consent of Parties. The seat, or legal place, of arbitration shall be Delhi. The language to be used in the arbitral proceedings shall be English. The courts of New Delhi, India shall have exclusive jurisdiction arising out of arbitration or matters requiring intervention of courts.

8.4. Though the MoA between parties is not legally binding towards one another, it shall still come under the rule of law in India.


**Kalindi College** is a constituent college of the University of Delhi, situated at East Patel Nagar, New Delhi. The College strives to cater to the higher education of young women with a vision of a new, fulfilling future for all. The Transgender Cell of Kalindi College is a newly constituted cell that works in close association with the Women's Development Cell of Kalindi College. In the past, the Women's Development Cell has successfully organized workshops, seminars, talks, film screenings, legal awareness programs to induce gender-equal frameworks of rights. It is the foremost platform that addresses gender issues in the college. It has the mission to promote inclusiveness and gender justice on the college campus. It has been striving to reach greater heights in academic endeavors, student engagements, and outreach programs spanning over many decades. It has been the most effective instrument in creating awareness among the teaching faculty, non-teaching staff, and students about existential problems that plague women's lives and ways to mitigate them.

**Nazariya Foundation** is a Queer Feminist Resource Group that was formed in October 2014 by a group of Delhi-based queer feminist activists. It was started to sensitize the work and culture of groups and individuals working on issues of gender-based violence, livelihoods, education, and health from a queer perspective through research & evaluations, capacity building, and advocacy.

Nazariya uses the word queer for people who have diverse sexual orientations and gender identities. 
Nazariya Foundation's understanding of sexuality also moves beyond violence and identities. The organization believes that sexuality is a lens to help analyze structures and institutions by which we can address issues of marginalization and inclusivity in a holistic manner.


**Mission:** Nazariya is led and run by queer persons. With a focus on queer women and trans\*<sup>1</sup> persons, Nazariya works with a vision to making LGBT\*QIA+ lives visible. The organization firmly believes that all queer persons have the capability and capacity to demand their rights and speak for themselves provided that they have access to resources and equal opportunities in a non-discriminatory environment. The organization advocates for creating such an environment.

**Nazariya's focus areas:**

1. **Capacity building to institutionalise gender and sexuality perspectives:**  
Discrimination faced by people marginalized because of their gender identity and sexual orientation from family, school, friends, and workspace is a reality. This along with the intersection of caste, class, religion, ability, ethnicity adds to the discrimination and violence faced by them. As a queer feminist organization, through gender & sexuality workshops we want to enable participants to understand these marginalizations, discriminations, intersections and equip participants to see the world from the lens of gender and sexuality. Additionally, another important component to our work is related to initiating conversations/building capacities of organizations around burnout prevention and stress management at the workspace.

Nazariya Foundation has been working with various schools and colleges, government agencies, Civil Society Organisations (CSOs) as well as various public forums and citizen's collectives in Delhi on various awareness-raising sensitization programs and workshops on lived realities of LGBT\*QIA+ persons as well as the discourse on LGBT\*QIA+ rights and entitlements. Some of our past collaborations have been with spaces like Tagore International School, Noida Metro Rail Corporation, Room to Read, Wada Na Todo Abhiyan (WNTA), House of Belongg, TARSHI, and many more.

The organization also seeks to empower the LGBT\*QIA+ persons and community through various skill-building programs on understanding their own identities and lived realities through fellowship programs for queer students, peer support counseling workshops, skill-building centres, and allied workshops as the need arises.


2. **Resource Centre to provide accessible information to LGBT\*QIA+ people:** Nazariya organises discussions and research on issues that impact queer lives, creating a platform for diverse and marginalized voices, rehabilitation options, and mental health.


The organization's office also serves as a drop-in center for queer persons in need of information and a sense of community. The queer persons can reach out to us for accessing the space between 11 am to 5 pm from Monday to Friday.

As an LGBT\*QIA+ organization, Nazariya also caters to the mental well-being of the community. For this purpose, the organization provides pro-bono counseling for those queer persons in need of mental health-related counseling and allied needs. As an added effect of the ongoing global pandemic of Covid-19, the organization has also started to conduct grief support meets, art-based therapy groups, and seeking to increase the capacity of the current mental health unit. The current mental unit has queer therapists who are affirming towards marginalized communities.

3. **Advocacy and networking to amplify voices of queer women and trans\* persons:** Sharing the queer perspective and lived realities of queer persons with institutions and government fosters an inclusive environment. Nazariya organizes workshops for human rights defenders, civil society organizations, corporate houses, citizens' collectives, and allied enterprises on how to foster inclusive space where LGBT\*QIA+ identified persons are able to access the space, resources, and services without facing violence and discrimination. Nazariya also conducts similar awareness programs on diversity and inclusion-based hiring policies and processes for the above-mentioned parties.

Nazariya also works towards advocating the plight, needs, and voices of LGBT\*QIA+ persons in public forums and related discourses as well as people's movements. Nazariya also provides necessary legal and allied helps to LGBT\*QIA+ persons in need and who are above 18 years of age.

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

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

## What is Gender?



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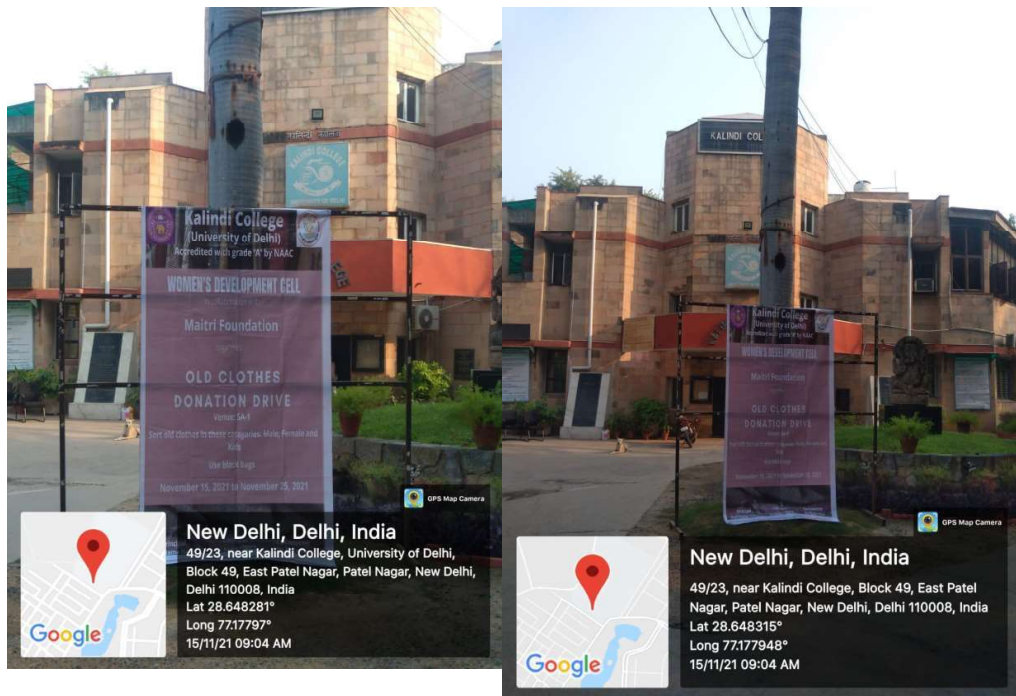

- अध्यापन एवं प्रशिक्षण के लिए विशेषज्ञ अतिथि प्रवक्ताओं को भी बुलाया जा सकता है जिसके मानदेय का भुगतान दोनों कॉलेज अपने अनुसार करेंगे। कुल 32 घंटे (कक्षाएं) होंगी।
