7.1.9 Sensitization of students and employees of the Institution to the constitutional obligations: values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens

a. **Spreading election awareness among students** Department of Political Science organised National Voters' Day (NVD) on Jan 25 in partnership with Sanjivani (NGO) and Chief Electoral Office, Delhi. The theme of 2016 NVD was "Inclusive and Qualitative Participation" and the slogan was 'NO VOTER SHOULD BE LEFT BEHIND'.

b. One Billion Rising: Sensitization for violence against women

On the initiative of Department of Political Science on 5th February 2016, Kalindi College became the third college of University of Delhi to have participated in the One Billion Rising movement, the global mass action to end all types of violence against women.

The programme also included

- ☐ Screening of movie on "Immoral Daughters" (based on honour killing);
- ☐ Flash Mob by students on "Jaago Dilli Jaago, abhi nahi sahenge" trained by Srijanatmaka Maanushi Samstha (SMS)
- ☐ Street Play by Raqs, the Dramatic Society of the College.

c. Blood Donation Camp

The volunteers from Blood Connect organized an awareness camp on blood donation in the college premises on 7th March 2016. The NSS unit of Kalindi College organized Blood Donation Camp in association with the Social Responsibility Cell of the college. It witnessed mass participation from students resulting in collection of more than 76 units of blood.

d. Teaching kids of construction workers

Kalindi College to take the responsibility of educating children of under privileged construction workers. by Manisha and Monika (B.A. Hon. III, Pol. Science) along with the teacher Dr. Deepak Yadav conducted regular classes for them. The basic stationary materials like copies, pencils, pens, English and Hindi alphabets books, numbers and table charts were provided to these under privileged children free of cost.

e. Awareness Programme on Thalassaemia

Workshop cum awareness programme on Thalassaemia had been organized by the Women Development Centre on 06.01.2016. Dr. Tejinder Singh, Consultant Orthopist Past President Rotary Club of Delhi, Safdarjung Hospital, had been invited for the workshop. She had also shown a beautiful documentary movie acted by herself for the awareness of Thalassaemia Major and Minor.

f. Women Empowerment self-defence

Kalindi college in association with the Central District Delhi Police, organized a month-long self-defence training workshop in the college premises. Students from all courses were mandatorily required to undergo 10 days of self-defence training. The workshop was conducted jointly by Sh. Shiv Kumar Kohli, a martial arts trainer and Ms. Kiran Sethi, ASI, Delhi Police. Further around 150 students participated in a self defense show organized by Delhi Police on the occasion of International Women's Day at Delhi University Indoor Stadium.

g. International Seminar Department of Sanskrit “Sanskrit Literature and Human Values”

The Department of Sanskrit, Kalindi College organized two-day International Seminar in collaboration with Delhi Sanskrit Academy to commemorate the Golden Jubilee celebration on 2nd and 3rd March, 2017 entitled ‘Sanskrit Literature and Human Values’. Dr. AnulaMaurya, Principal of college welcomed the Chief Guest and Dignitaries. The event was honoured by Chief Guest Prof. Dinesh Singh, Former Vice-Chancellor, Delhi University, Prof. MaltiAuckle, HOD, School of Indological Studies Mahatma Gandhi Institute Moka, Mauritius, Prof. Sharda Sharma, HOD, Delhi University, Prof. MislavJezic, Eminent Indologist Faculty of Philosophy, University of Zegred, Croatia. 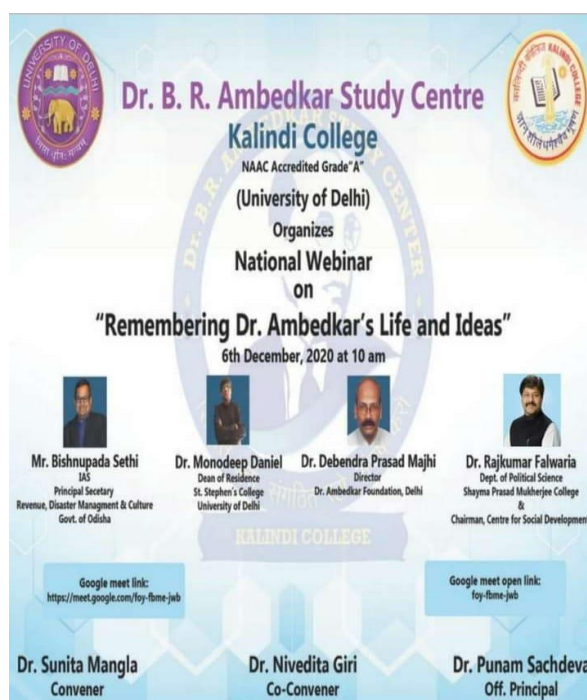

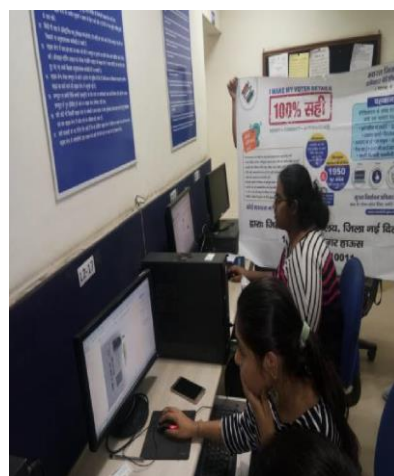


- World wetland day: 2nd february 2018: Students of Zoology Hons Ist year and faculty members of the Zoology Department went to Okhla Bird Sanctuary.
