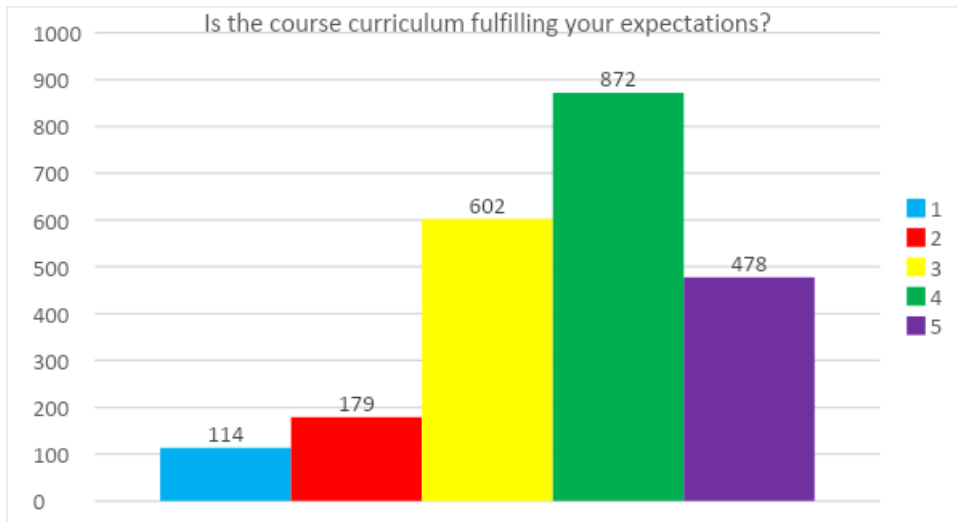
1. How do you rate your satisfaction level with reference to the curriculum design?

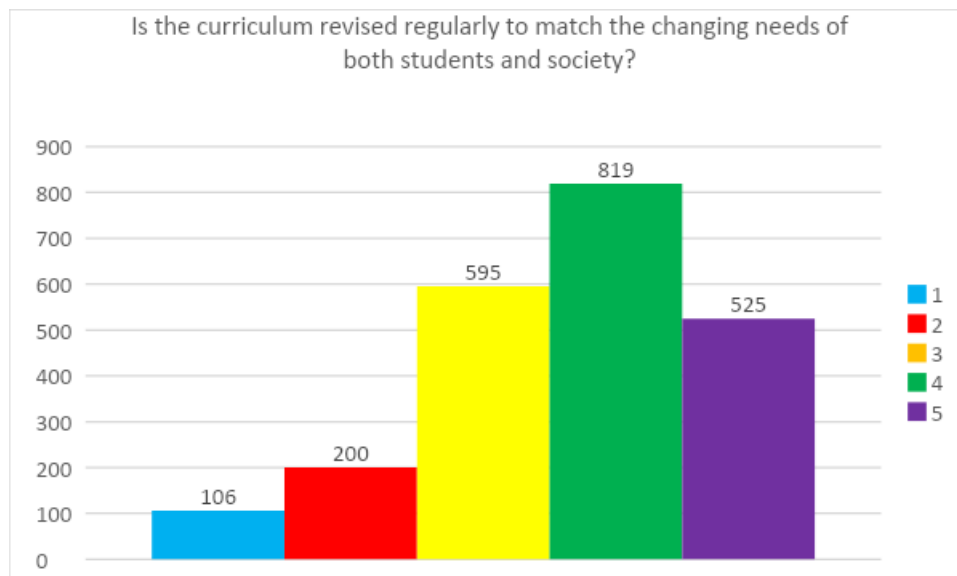
2. Is the course curriculum fulfilling your expectations?

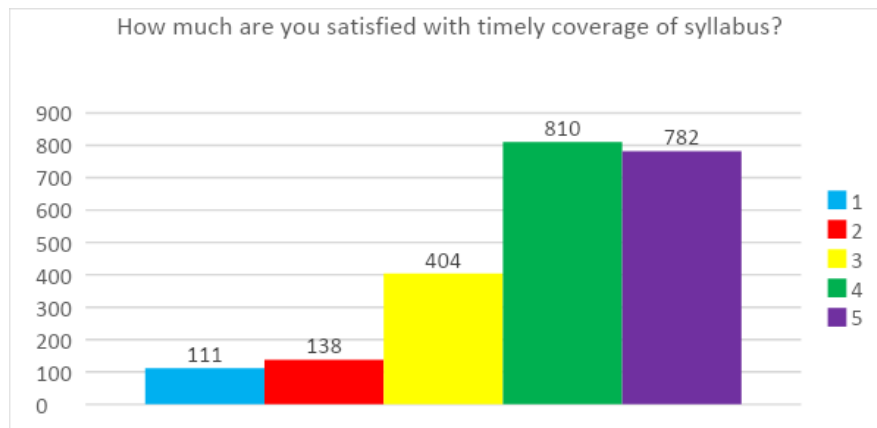
3. Is the curriculum revised regularly to match the changing needs of both students and society?

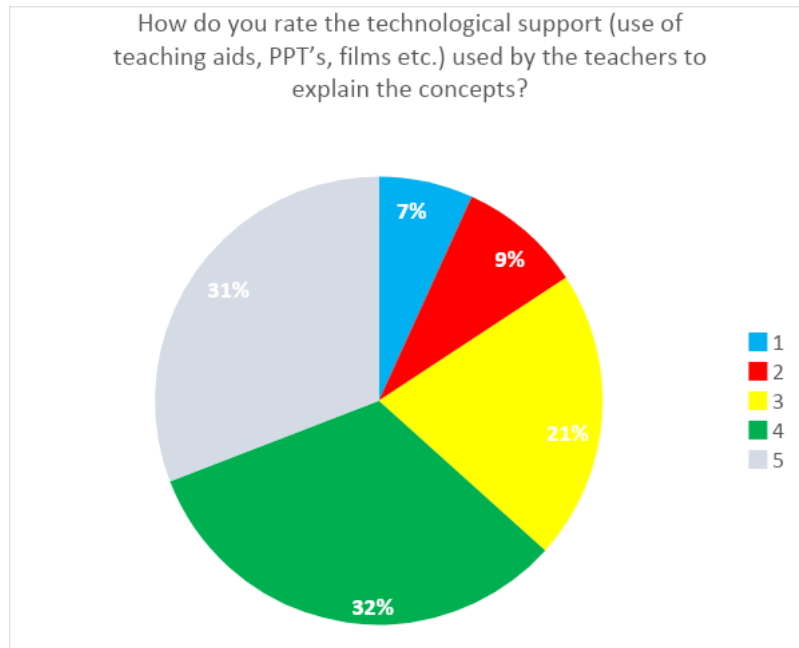
4. How much are you satisfied with timely coverage of syllabus?

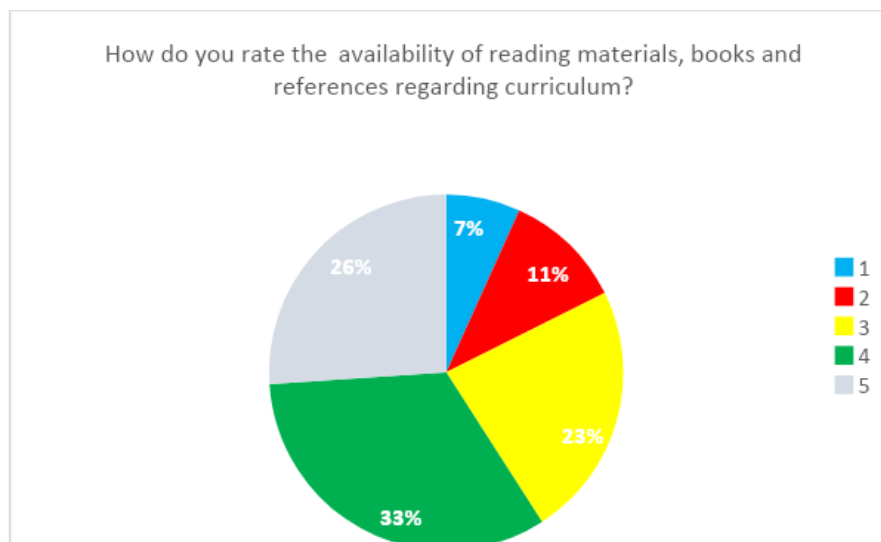
5. How do you rate the technological support (use of teaching aids, PPT's, films etc.) used by the teachers to explain the concepts?

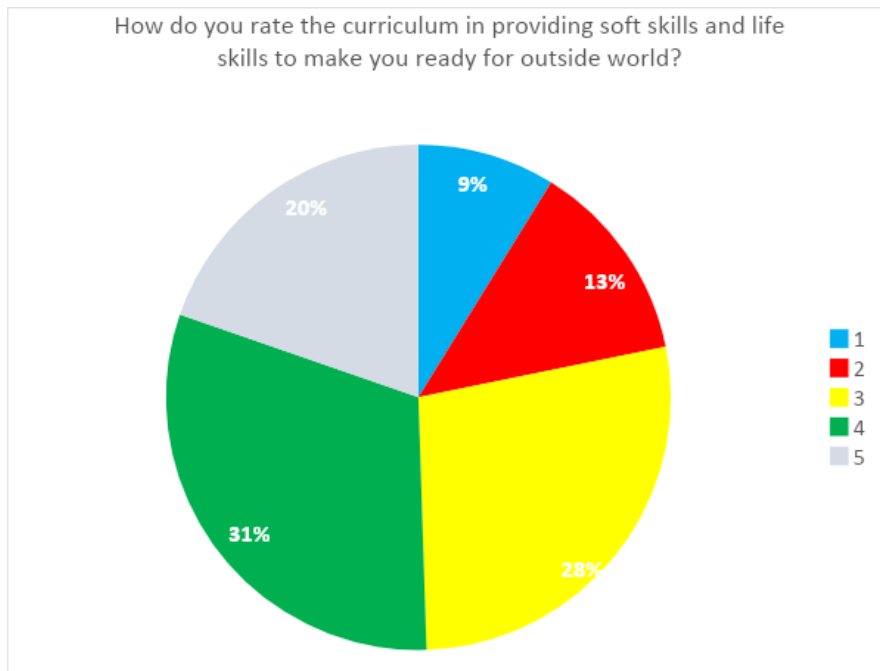
6. How do you rate the availability of reading materials, books and references regarding curriculum?

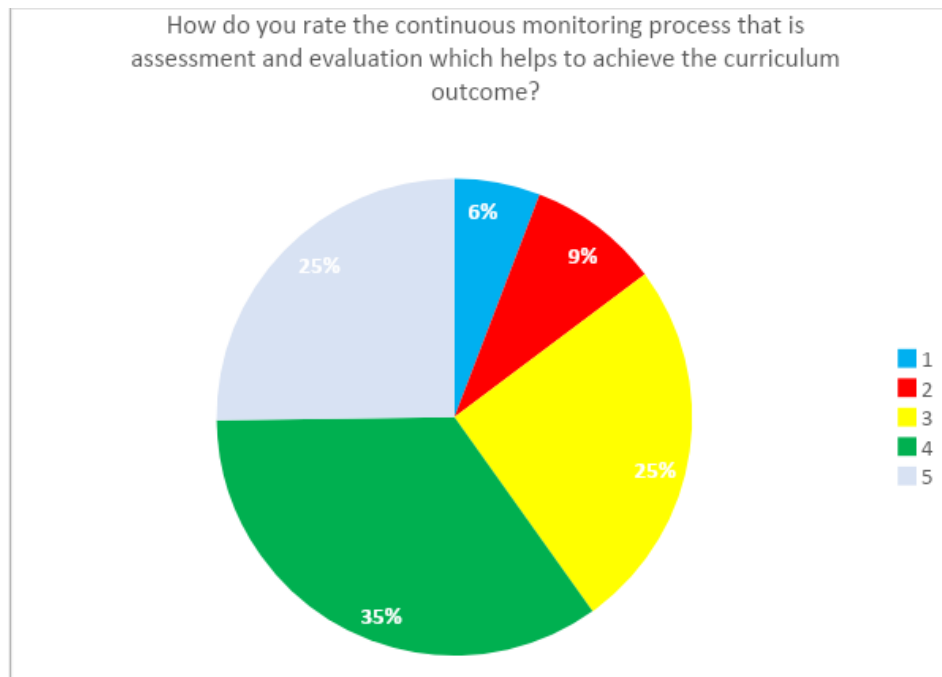
7. How do you rate the curriculum in providing soft skills and life skills to make you ready for outside world?

Feedback Analysis:

The Curriculum Feedback form for the students asked them to mark their preferences from 1 to 5, where 1 - Unsatisfactory, 2 – Satisfactory, 3- Good, 4 – Very good and 5 – Excellent.

In the analysis, if 70% and above students have marked ‘3 (Good), 4(Very good), 5(Excellent)’ to a particular question then it is considered as a highly satisfied response. If 30% and above students have marked 1 (Unsatisfactory) or 2 (Satisfactory) in their responses, then it is taken as not satisfied / contended and requires improvement.

Main Points:

- 88% of students were highly satisfied with the design of their curriculum and 87% agreed that the Curriculum was fulfilling their expectations.
- 86% of respondents agreed that the curriculum was revised regularly to match the changing needs of the students and society.
- As far as the timely coverage of syllabus was concerned, 89% students were highly satisfied with it.
- According to 84% of the respondents, teachers were using technological support (PPT’s, films etc) to explain the concepts.
- 82% students were satisfied with the availability of reading materials, books and references regarding curriculum.
- 78% students agreed that the curriculum provided them soft skills and life skills.

- With respect to assessment and evaluation to achieve the curriculum outcome, 85% students were highly satisfied with it.
