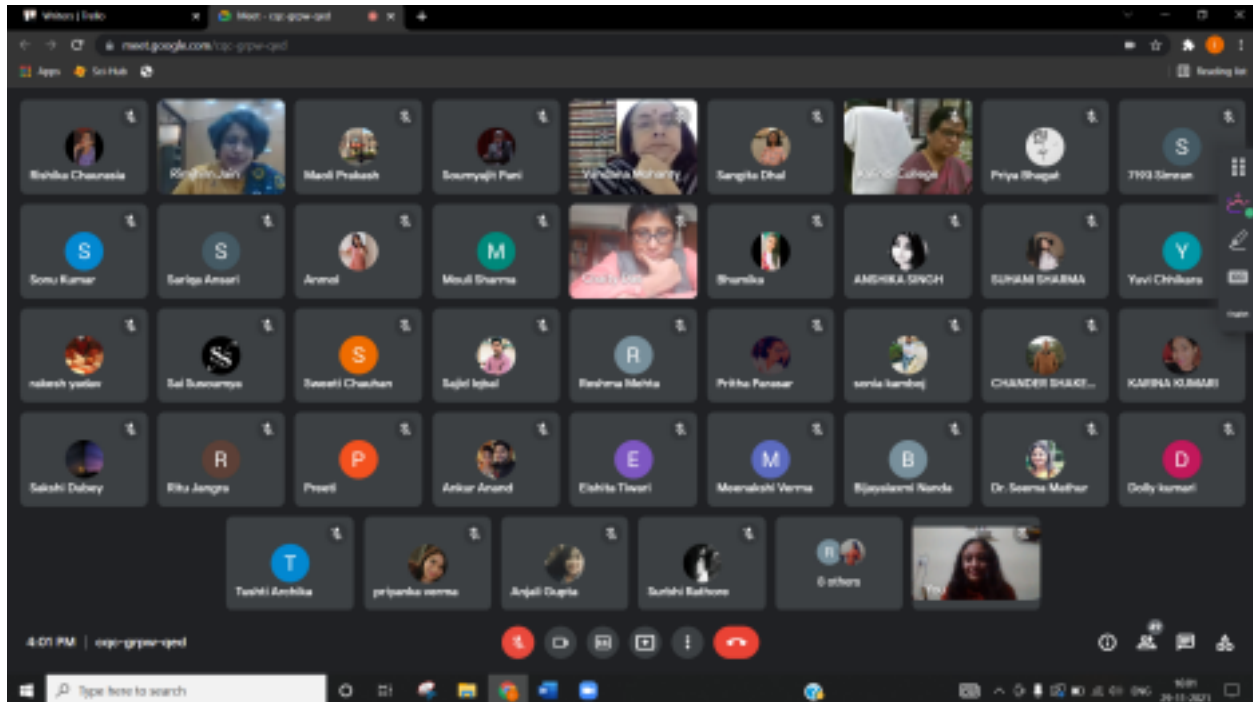

MS. RIMJHIM JAIN, Technical Specialist on Ending Violence Against Women, UN Women.

To celebrate the occasion Ms Jain threw light on gender-based violence and the different forms it can take. Talking about the importance of having an intersectional perspective towards issues highlighting gender-based violence. Further highlighting atrocities observed during the COVID-19 pandemic and explaining why it is important for everyone, regardless of their gender, to be a part of the conversation and understand gender and patriarchy. She lay emphasis on the importance of dialogue and transparency in the entire process.

MR. SOUMYAJIT PANI, Advocate, Supreme Court & Member, Gender Sensitisation & Internal Committee (GSIC), addressed the legal aspects pertaining to the agenda and decoded the role of the internal committee and its significance in bringing about change. 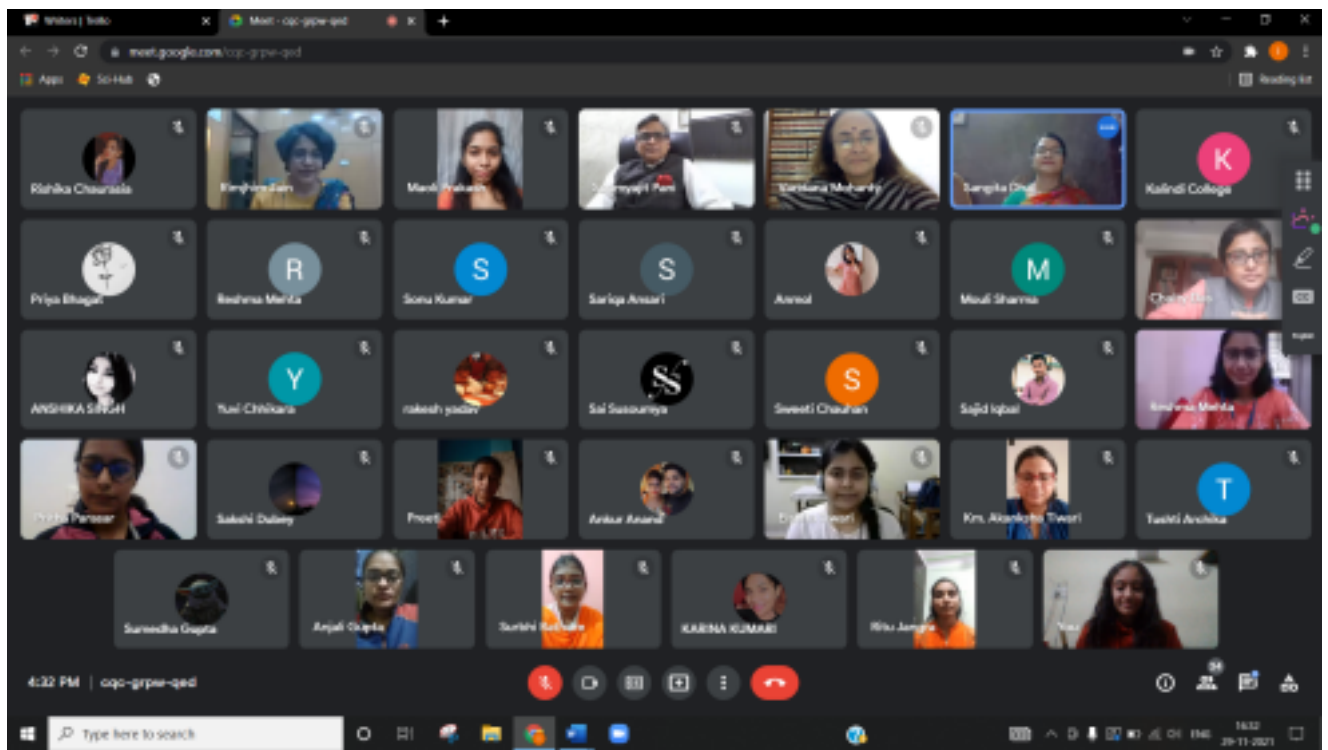
