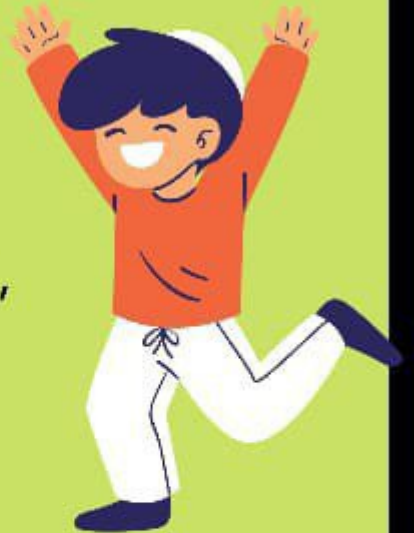

Ahora quiero explicar el papel de Gandhi en la actualidad. Gandhi todavía tiene una enorme relevancia hoy en día, en una variedad de campos. En sus escritos y práctica política, Gandhi se comprometió críticamente con temas que siguen siendo importantes en nuestros tiempos: industrialismo, tecnología, capitalismo, liberalismo, democracia y violencia; en definitiva, la modernidad en todas sus diversas manifestaciones. Creo que Gandhi es más relevante ahora que nunca. A lo largo de su carrera política, trabajó con la distinción entre la eficacia de la no violencia y la futilidad de la violencia, una distinción que dio forma a su idea de la India. Esto contrastaba con los actores políticos que proponían una idea alternativa de la India y abogaban por la violencia como instrumento de poder y soberanía. Estas dos ideas rivales, la de la no violencia y la de la

violencia, han dado forma a concepciones antagónicas de la India

moderna.

Según el video y los textos mucha gente dice que la India ha abandonado el legado de Gandhi y que (los indios) han tomado un camino muy diferente. Cuando dice eso no quiere generalizar, pero la mayoría de los indios parecen haberse desviado del camino gandhiano. Estoy de acuerdo con estas personas, creo que la gente cambió la opinión de Gandhi sobre su legado. Si hablamos de ejemplos reales he estudiado un ejemplo más para el nuevo papel de Gandhi que es la importancia de Gandhi no se puede reducir solo a palabras, tiene que ser vista en acciones y hechos. Ese tipo de disciplina es muy necesaria en nuestro país para mantener el legado de Gandhi.

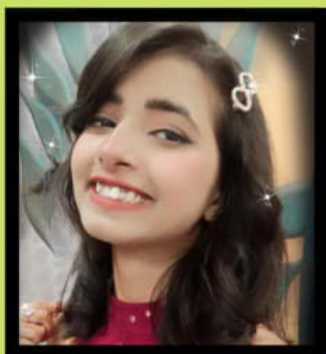

opportunity to grow and learn lessons that would have not been possible otherwise. Thank you for always supporting and believing in us.

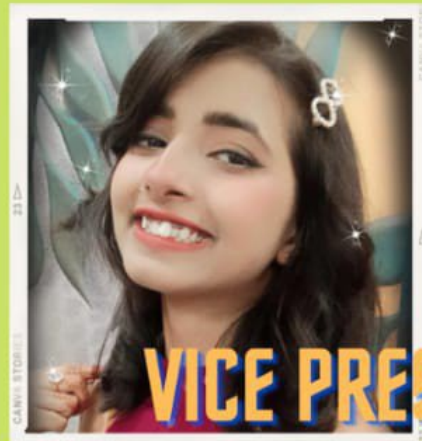
