Dr.AbhishekTandon, Deputy Director, ICSSR, graced the event as the chief Guest. The Principal, Prof. Naina Hasija, then welcomed the guests for the day.

The president of Kalindi College Students' Union, Ms. Vashundhra Singh, introduced the Parikram Diwas ceremony with a cursory introduction of India's gone but never forgotten warrior, gallant Subhash Chandra Bose. As a tribute to Netaji and other great freedom fighters of India, Chitrajita Gupta sang a patriotic song in her melodious voice.

The keynote speaker for the event, Dr.Saumyajit Ray from School of International Studies, JNU mesmerized all by his exceptional knowledge on Netaji's life, his family, his childhood, his dedication and immense love for nation, INA and how he inspired several youth movements to achieve India's liberty at core. The life stories of Netaji, lifted up the patriotic spirits of all participants. Dr. Ray also enlightened everyone about how India's Independence activist stanned Swami Vivekananda, the nineteenth-century Indian Hindu monk, as his spiritual teacher. He also expressed his grief on the unpaid recognition and appreciation to Netaji for his incontestable service for the nation and applauded the unveiling of Netaji's statue at India gate as the first step of a long journey made by the central government.





An online spiritual talk on LIFE LESSONS FROM MAHABHARATA was conducted for the students of Kalindi College by the Students' Union with SHRI SHUBHA VILAS JI as the Chief Speaker. He is a lifestyle management coach, storyteller, TedX Speaker and author of some best selling books including Ramayana: The game of life and Open Eyed Meditation who has delivered such talks in many countries and MNCs. His radiant aura is inevitable for the audience to ignore. The Convener Dr Renu Gupta welcomed Shubh Vilas ji to start the session.

Prabhu ji flared a green flag to the webinar with the ideal and most devotional way, a prayer to the almighty. He did a presentation for better understanding. He began with a brief introduction of the Indian epic, MAHABHARATA, "book of leadership". Prabhu ji beautifully depicted the interconnection of our life and the epic as a question answer relationship. He gave life to the stories of Mahabharata as he narrated some of them; each story was linked to a crucial aspect of life such as success and failure, happiness, focus, ambitions, desires, emotional bonding and perception.

The way Prabhu ji elaborated the Mahabharata transformed the way the epic has been perceived. He shed light on the 5 factors behind success, namely Person, Place, Instruments, Endeavors and Daiwo (hand of God). In addition to this, he briefed the students with 4 yugas: 'Sat Yuga' where God and Demons lived in different planets, 'Treta Yuga' where they lived in different countries, 'Dwapar Yuga' where they resided in same country and same family and the 'Kal Yuga', where they are in same person. He also gave an insight in people's minds and live and taught how the essence of life is hidden in such epics. The sense of calmness and spirituality the webinar instilled in all the participants is beyond words.

At last, a questionnaire session was catered in which Prabhu ji acknowledged questions about imperfections, quest for success, dealing with anger, finding purpose of life, moral decline and importance of spirituality and devotion in politics.

To conclude the webinar, a vote of thanks was presented by Dr. Janhawi to Prabhu ji for taking out time from his packed schedule and blessing the college with the privilege of hosting him. It was indeed an enlightening, awakening and informative webinar. It was an experience all present wished to have again.
