General Rules

11. The participants are expected to maintain decorum within the college premises and remain within norms and discipline.

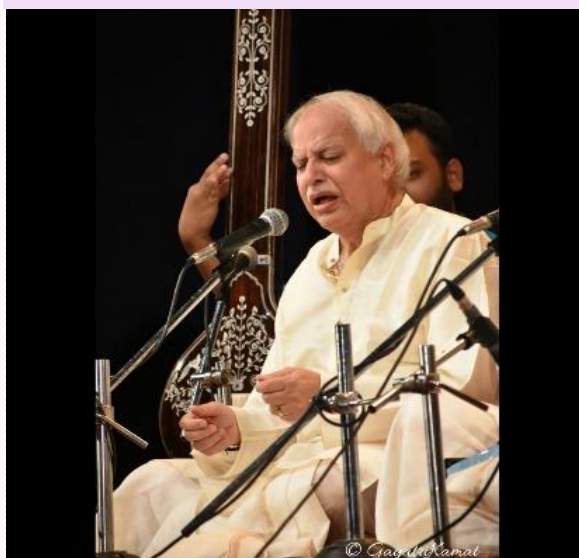

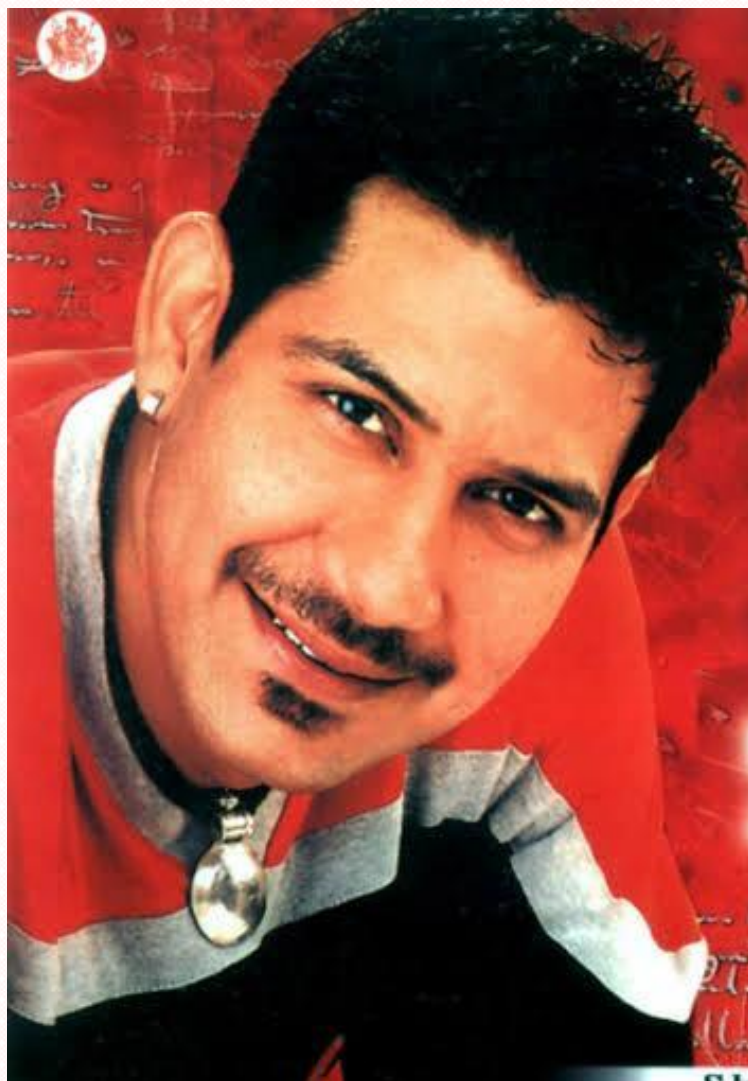
