




Q3: Count of Facilities provided by the college [Availability of resources(Journals , Magazines , Newspapers) etc]








Q4: Count of Facilities provided by the college [Office Assistance]








Q5: Count of Basic Amenities in College [Campus]






Q6: Count of Basic Amenities in College [Classrooms]








Q7: Count of Basic Amenities in College [Laboratories]








Q8: Count of Basic Amenities in College [Corridors]








Q9: Count of Basic Amenities in College [Toilets]










Q12: Count of Basic Amenities in College [Quality of food in canteen]








Q14. Count of Basic Amenities in College [cyber center]








Q25 Teaching and Learning Experience(Guidance to overcome weaknesses)








Q26 Percentage of syllabus covered in the class.








Q29 Rate overall quality of teaching-learning experience in your institute.

ANALYSIS: MAIN POINTS

- With regard to *college facilities*, students find most facilities -information on college website (76 % positive response), office assistance (75% positive response) books, & study material (70% positive response) as *excellent* while others are *satisfied* with 67% positive response.
- With concern to *basic amenities* students are highly gratified (find it excellent) with cyber centre (72 % positive response), whereas have shown *satisfaction* with the other amenities.
- The data denotes that the students seem to be somewhat *satisfied* with laboratories (69% positive response) campus (61% positive response), classroom (52% positive response), corridors (62% positive response), canteen hygiene (54% positive response), quality of canteen food (52% positive response) and drinking water (43% positive response). Whereas Toilets needs high improvement with (39% responses). However, it is also indicative that these amenities can be made better.
- Respondents find *co-curricular activities in the department* societies excellent. 76 per cent of the respondents have given excellent response for the same.
- Activities/ events organized by the *clubs* are excellent with 75 % positive response.
- The students are highly gratified (excellent) with their respective *NCC/Sports /NSS* clubs. 92 % of the students have joined sports. 80% excellent response for the students' over all experience with their registered clubs.
- Overall, students are very happy with their *teaching-learning experience*.
- The percentage of respondents who have given *excellent response* for various teaching-learning elements are as follows: for effective communication between student and teacher(87%), extent of interaction during the class (84%), punctuality and regularity of the teachers (84%), internal-assessment evaluation process (80%), encouragement to participate in extracurricular activities (80%), guidance to overcome weakness (79%), and use of ICT tools (74%) in classrooms.
- *Mentor-mentee experience* indicates excellent experience as 79 percent of the students seem very happy with it.
- Around 40 percent, 42 percent, 10 percent, 2 percent and 6% of the respondents have marked that 100 %, 80-100%, 60-80%, together 40-60%, and less than 40 % of the *syllabus was covered*, respectively.
- The response indicates *satisfaction* with initiatives taken by college to promote *field trips, internships*, and to help students explore further opportunities. 60 percent of students' response indicate positive response in this regard.
- *Overall teaching-learning* experience of the students is good. 67 percent respondents have marked positive response.

*Parameters:

Excellent: $x \ge 70$

Satisfactory: $40 \% \le x < 70 \%$

High level of improvement: x < 40%

*x is the percentage of response obtained by adding the response % of excellent + very good + good in a question.
