- The Role of Reasonable User Charges in Financing the National Infrastructure Pipeline 199
Kumar V. Pratap and Manshi Gupta

It is well accepted that infrastructure is necessary for growth and development. To give added thrust to infrastructure, India has released its first-ever National Infrastructure Pipeline (NIP) with estimated investments of over Rs.111 trillion till 2024-25. User charges are quite low in India, which often do not cover the operation and maintenance costs of infrastructure assets. As India suffers from increased fiscal stress because of the COVID 19 pandemic, reasonable user charges for infrastructure should be emphasised, which can also help finance the NIP.

RESEARCH

- Health Expenditures, Health Infrastructure and Health Status in SAARC Countries: A Panel Data Analysis 205
Subhalaxmi Mohapatra

This paper explores the differential effects of multiple health expenditure components and health infrastructure and socio-economic indicators on health outcomes in the SAARC region. Using, random effects panel regression on panel data from seven SAARC countries (1993-2012), the results showed differential effect public, private and out of pocket health expenditure on health outcomes. Out of pocket expenditure was the most significant influencer of life expectancy, death rate and instances of tuberculosis. Public expenditure was found to be influential for infant mortality rate. Results also indicated an important role of health infrastructure and socio-economic variables on health outcomes.

- Scale Purification and Validation: A Methodological Approach to Sustainable Online Retailing 217
Suhail Ahmad Bhat, Ajaz Akbar Mir and Sheikh Basharul Islam

The paper develops an instrument that captures sustainable online retailing by developing, measuring and empirically validating a scale. The study applies various scale purification and evaluation criteria for the methodology status quo of B2C online retailing. The scale development process was undertaken in three phases (item generation and item analysis; dimension reduction; confirmation and validation). The validity of scale was established by adopting a proper psychometric scale development procedure. The data was collected from the respondents in three phases involving survey methodology.

Isha Roy, Tanya Saini and Piyali Ghosh

Corporate India has already embraced gender diversity, but changing times demand workplaces to include other factors like age, sexual orientation, and religious affiliation while drafting diversity and inclusion policies. This case describes an organizational set-up in the manufacturing sector that claims to embrace all forms of diversity in its diversity policy. Yet, its top management is not ready to accept any deviation from traditional societal norms and terminates an employee once his alternative sexual preference is revealed. It showcases what the internal stakeholders of any company need to do to be truly inclusive and nurture all types of diversity.

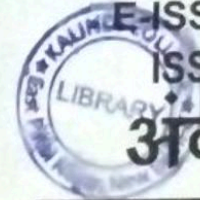
