

# NCC REPORT 2024–2025

*Kalindi College (5 Delhi Girls Battalion, Group B, Delhi Directorate)*

The National Cadet Corps (NCC) is the premier youth development organization of India, dedicated to instilling discipline, leadership, and a sense of service in young citizens. During the session 2024–2025, the Kalindi College NCC unit, under the guidance of Lt. Dr. Arti Singh (ANO), continued to inspire its cadets to excel in all spheres of training, adventure, and social service activities. With over 160 cadets from first, second, and third years, the unit actively participated in several prestigious national and college-level camps, competitions, and initiatives.

## Major Camps and Activities

- **Annual Training Camp – Delhi Cantt (17–26 May 2024):** The camp encompassed a wide range of activities including Group Dance, Skit, Squad, Kho-Kho, Singing, Best Cadet, Poster Making, Declamation, Book Review, Flag Area, Line Area, and Firing.
