
badge ceremony followed, where the newly appointed office bearers were honored for their leadership roles.


- Animal Wellness Day: Caring for Our Companions

Closing




Conclusion



He debunked common myths, explaining that while coding and mathematical skills are beneficial, strong analytical thinking and problem-solving abilities are equally crucial.

7. Fields Using Data Analysts

The speaker emphasized how industries like healthcare, finance, marketing, and technology are leveraging data analytics to drive strategic decisions.

- 2. Tiebreaker: In case of a tie, the team that returns to the starting point first will be declared the winner.

Disqualifications

- Cheating: Any team caught stealing or tampering with flags/clues will be disqualified.
- Unsportsmanlike Behavior:Rude or aggressive behavior towards other teams or organizers will not be tolerated.
- Violation of Rules: Failing to adhere to the safety guidelines or game rules will lead to disqualifications


Interactive Discussion and Q&A






Conclusion

Overview:

Rules & Regulations

1. Eligibility:

- Open to all undergraduate students of all universities and colleges in Delhi NCR (individuals or teams of two members).
- · Each team can submit only one idea.

2. Registration:

- · All teams must register by the given deadline.
- Team names and idea titles must be unique and appropriate.

3. Idea Submission:

- Submit a brief executive summary (1-page) covering:
 - Problem statement
 - Proposed solution
 - Target market
 - Revenue model (if applicable)
 - Unique selling point (USP)
- Optional: Pitch deck (max 5-7 slides) or short video (2-3 mins).

4. Round Structure:

- * Round 1: Screening / Idea Submission
- Judges shortlist teams based on originality, feasibility, and clarity.

Round 2: Elevator Pitch (Semi-finals)

- 2-3 minute verbal pitch without slides, followed by 2 mins of Q&A.
- Focus on clarity, confidence, and viability of the idea.

Round 3: Final Pitch (Grand Finale)

- 5 minutes detailed pitch presentation (PPT allowed), followed by 2 mins Q&A.
- · Must cover business model, market research, competition, and finances (if applicable).

5. Rules During the Event:

- · No offensive or plagiarized content.
- Time limits will be strictly enforced.
- Only team members can present; no external assistance.
- Judges' decision will be final and binding.



Pitch Perfect" was a dynamic and intellectually charged startup pitching competition, held as a part of *QUBIT'25* — the Inter-College Tech Fest organized by the **Computer Science Society of Kalindi College**, University of Delhi. The event took place on **11th April 2025** at CS LAB 1, bringing together enthusiastic undergraduate students from across universities and colleges in Delhi NCR.

The competition aimed to ignite the spirit of innovation and entrepreneurship among students, encouraging them to step out of their comfort zones and present real-world solutions through innovative startup ideas. Participants either registered individually or in teams of two, and each team could pitch only one unique business idea.

The event was structured into **three rounds**:

Screening Round: Teams submitted a one-page executive summary describing their startup idea, covering elements like problem statement, proposed solution, target market, revenue model, and unique selling point. This round ensured that only the most feasible and original ideas moved forward.

Elevator Pitch (Semi-Finals): Shortlisted teams delivered a 2–3 minute verbal pitch without any slides, followed by a short Q&A with the judges. This tested participants' ability to communicate their vision clearly and confidently under pressure.


