The Northeast and Himalayan region of India comprises of culturally and linguistically diverse ethnic groups. Its spatial and geographical location amongst other have made the regions relatively obscured and isolated from the rest of the nation. Seeking access to premier academic institutions and educational exposure, number of students coming to Delhi has increased exponentially over the years. And Delhi University receives the largest proportion of these aspiring students. Pertinently, the university and colleges have taken number of conducive steps to promote accessibility and smooth transition of students coming from the regions.

OBJECTIVE:

The Northeast Cell of Kalindi College is one of the oldest in the University of Delhi. It was constituted in 2012, even before the Government of India's directive mandating such cells in government-supported academic institutions was notified.

The cell underwent a structural revamp in the academic session 2024–25 with the inclusion of students from the Himalayan region into the fold of the Northeast Cell, thereby enhancing its diversity and reinforcing its collective identity. Nevertheless, the primary objectives of the cell have remained consistent, to address major challenges faced by students from these regions. Beginning with the admission process and related matters to familiarizing them with course disciplines and syllabi, the cell functions as a support system to help students adjust to a new environment.

It also acts as a bridge between students from the Northeast and Himalayan regions and those from the mainland, fostering conducive interaction and mutual understanding. The cell strives to promote unity in diversity among students from the Northeast, the Himalayan region, and beyond, within the university.

Kalindi College also has a much-awaited Northeastern Girls' Hostel facility project, currently underway on campus. The foundation stone of the hostel was laid by Prof. Dinabandhu Sahoo, the then Chairman of the Governing Body, in 2014.

ACTIVITIES OF THE CELL:

Since its inception, the Cell has organized various awareness and educational talk. Orientation programme for the first year's students is held regularly in the beginning of academic session. Educational and informational seminar, workshop and competition are held consistently, besides the annual inter-college cultural event. Students coming from the eight north-eastern states (Assam,

Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Nagaland Tripura and Sikkim) and Ladakh region effectively host and organized above mentioned programmes.

HOW DOES THE CELL WORK?

The Cell works through under the headship of a convenor selected during academic council committees' allotment. The other committee members include a co-convenor and members from among the faculty. For smooth functioning, faculty members then select 10 to 12 students as office bearers (OBs) from different batches through nomination and interviews every year. Selected representatives run the cell in consultation with faculty in charges to ensure amicable and conducive atmosphere. They execute and expedite the Cell's objective and visions. The Northeast & Himalayan Frontier Students' Cell of Kalindi College work towards promoting robust cultural interactions, holistic education, equality, sense of fraternity among students and overall harmony within plurality in the college.
