IQAC vision and mission

IQAC works, to make quality the defining element of higher education through a combination of self and external quality evaluation, promotion and sustenance initiatives. In this process IQAC took various measures such as:

- **AQAR 2023-24 preparation and submission:** IQAC prepared and submitted AQAR 2023-24 on 27-01-2025.
- **Quality Assurance:** IQAC took several quality assurance measures such as-
 - Formation of Policy Documents for Community Outreach and Extension activities in association with all the departments.
 - Conducted Physical Visit in labs and departments.
 - IQAC with PTSI (Parent-Teacher-Student-Interface) Committee conducted Parent teachers meeting on 22-02-2024.
 - IQAC with General Assembly Committee organised General Assembly of students on 19-03-2024.
 - IQAC though feedback committee, has started taking online feedback from all the stakeholders of the college.
- **IQAC's proposal and under execution plans**
 - IQAC has started working on paperless compilation of individual/faculty APAR and Department Academic Audit for the AQAR data filling.
 - AQAR Committee was updated,
 - IQAC suggested Research Project Allocation Committee (RPAC) to revise its guidelines; and also finalized the In-house project for the academic year 2024-25.
 - IQAC has scheduled physical visits to labs, academic and administrative facilities in April-May 2025.

- **Promotion under CAS 2018:** IQAC has successfully processed the promotion of 15 faculty members as: 06 faculty from Stage I to II, 02 from Stage II to III; 05 from Stage III to IV (Associate Professor); and 02 from Associate Professor to Professor.
- **Workshop/FDP/Seminar; Outreach and extension activities:** IQAC also has been involved in organizing training/workshops/awareness programmes in association with different committees of the college as:

Community Outreach and extension activities

This year IQAC has started to join hand with all the department and encouraged them to conduct community outreach activities to develop social belongingness among students towards society and following activities have been conducted:

- Community outreach activity was conducted in association with Amaranth -The Botanical Society, Department of Botany on 16-11-2025 with the objective “Hygiene & Nutrition: Importance in Daily Life”; in which students and teachers of the department visited Slum cluster near CGO complex, Jungpura and conducted a full day awareness campaign for the slum dwellers and the people were informed about the necessity of personal hygiene and nutritional intake for a healthy life, also soap and some edible items were distributed to children.
- A community outreach, was conducted in association with Dhanverse, Finance Cell, Department of Commerce on 11-02-2025. Under this activity a “Digital Awareness-cum Training Session” for the students of S.D. Girls Sr. Sec. School, East Patel Nagar; was conducted to educate them about how to avoid financial transaction risks with the aim to impart knowledge and skills which make students cautious about their financial transactions. Feedback cum hands-on practice was conducted and also discussed with the school administration to conduct such sessions throughout the year.
- Another outreach activity was organized in association with Department of Chemistry under the theme “Inspire & Include” on 27-03-2025 in Chemistry lab. The students and teachers of the department conducted various hands-on training and educational activities for a group of bright and spirited children from the Salaam Baalak Trust. The sessions conducted for them with the aim to introduced the young visitors to fascinating concepts in science and technology as well as created a platform for mutual learning.

Workshops/conferences/Trainings and other programs

IQAC also has been involved in organizing training/workshops/awareness programmes in association with different committees of the college such as:

- In collaboration with Garden Committee and IQAC, A Plantation Drive with the theme "Grow a Tree for Life," an Environmental Action Programme under the guidance of Prof. Dinabandhu Sahoo, Head, Department of Botany, University of Delhi; was organized on 15-07-2024 at college campus in which various fruiting and medicinal plant saplings were planted in the college.

- A seminar and paper presentation competition on the topic “*Real Dhan: Human Health-A Step Towards Arogyata*” was organized in association with Department of Commerce and Garden Committee on 31-01-2025 at college. 89 students and all the faculty members of commerce department participated in this event, the seminar was inaugurated with an invited talk of Prof. Sushma Agrawal (Rtd), Laxmibai College, University of Delhi.
 - Department of Computer Science in association with IQAC organized an “*Awareness Campaign and Mammography Screening Camp*” with collaboration “Doctors for You” on 14-11-2024 in college campus. On this full day campaign, students and all the teaching & non-teaching female staff were encouraged to participate in this self-examination training and mammography screening camp.
 - IQAC in association with राजभाषा कार्यान्वयन समिति (*Rajbhasha Karyanvan Samiti*), organized an invited on 27-02-2025 and Prof. P.C. Tandan (Former Head, Department of Hindi, University of Delhi) delivered a lecture on the topic “*Swatantra Bharat Me Hindi Me Kamkaj Ki Anivaryata*” (स्वतंत्र भारत में हिन्दी में कामकाज की अनिवार्यता).
 - IQAC in association with Hindi Sahitya Parishad, Department of Hindi organized an invited talk on 18-09-2024 under the theme *Hindi Pakhwada* (4-09-2023 to 26-09-2023), where students, Office and Account Staff as well teaching staff attended this talk on “वैश्वीकरण के दौर में हिन्दी” delivered by Dr. Vipul Sunil, Assistant Professor, Department of Hindi, University of Delhi.
 - IBSD Committee in association with IQAC conducted a National Conference on “*Sustainable Startups: Integrating Traditional Knowledge with Innovation*”, on 17-02-2025. This conference included two speakers Col. Shri Kishor Chand Singh, Rtd Col., Indian Army, Imphal and Shri Anand Bhardwaj, Rtd Eng. DJB & Social Worker (in North East India); were invited who delivered their talks on relevance of traditional knowledge and opportunities in entrepreneurship in North East India in present scenario. 84 participations were recorded in the program and 15 Poster presentation were registered in which students of north east region studying in Delhi university presented their innovative ideas towards entrepreneurship during this conference.
 - Three Day long “*Free Health Checkup Camp*” from 17-02-2025 to 19-02-2025 was organized by *Kalpdhara*, The Environmental Society in association with IQAC & Clove India. In this health checkup camp students and staff were benefitted with more than 30 type of medical test and medical counselling as well.
- **New Initiative: “आज का शब्द”**
IQAC in association with राजभाषा कार्यान्वयन समिति (*Rajbhasha Karyanvan Samiti*), has started a new practice of learning a one Hindi word each day, under the theme “आज का शब्द” in which the committee write a new word of Hindi, i.e. used in official work, on a board placed at a strategic so that each one can be encouraged to learn the word.
