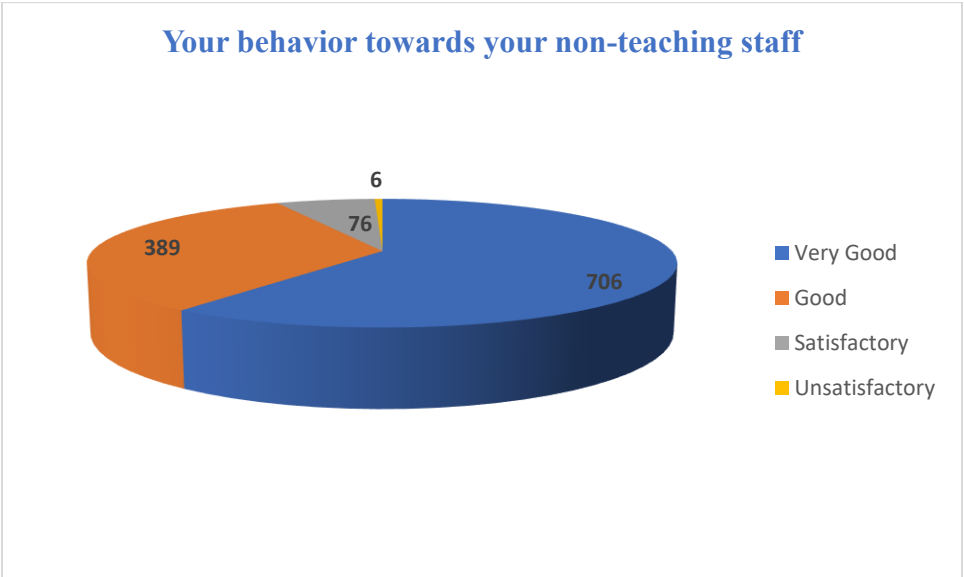
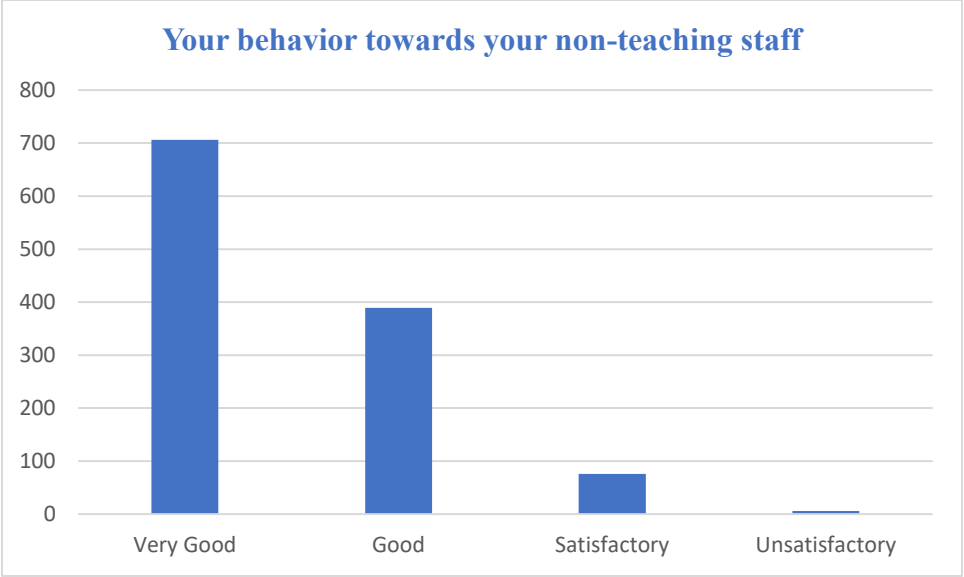


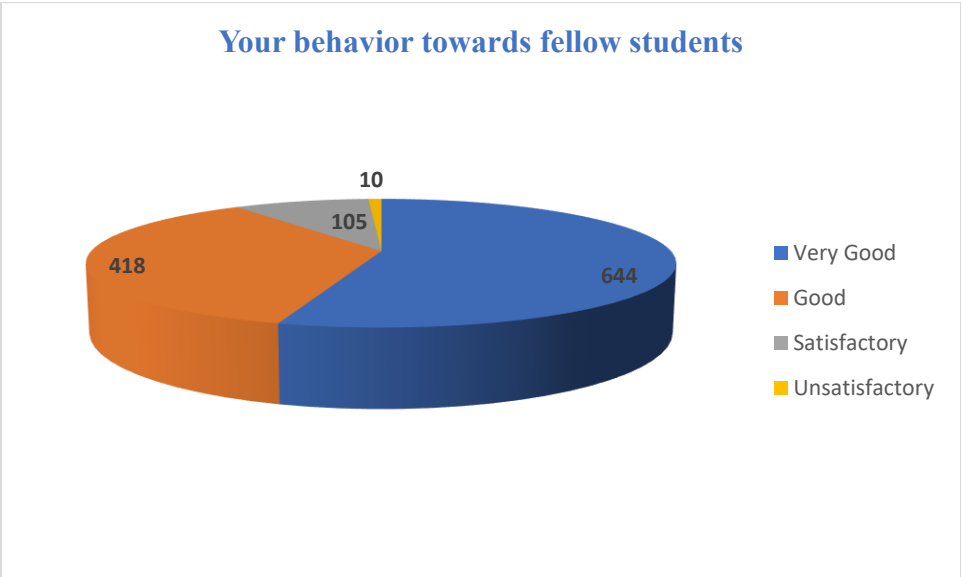
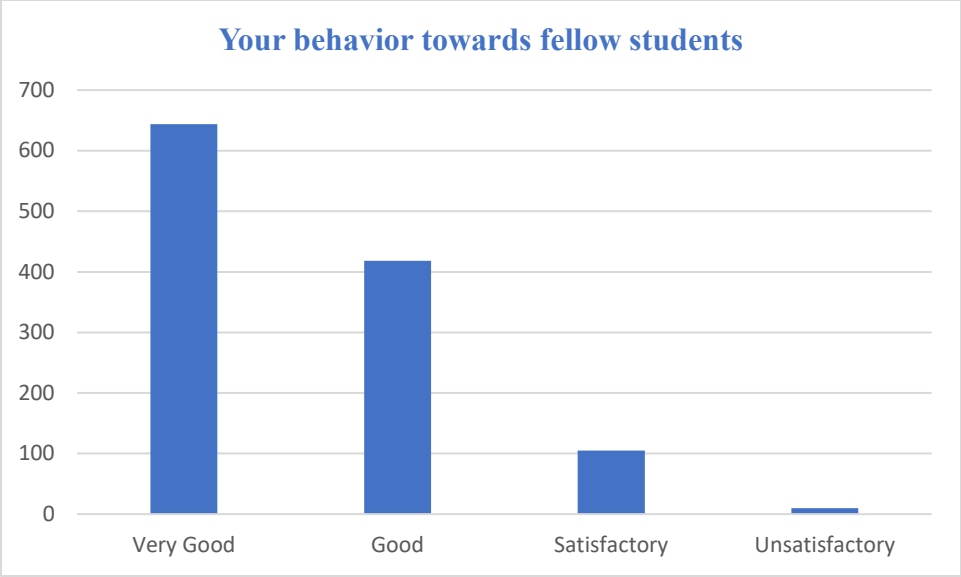












## ANALYSIS: MAIN POINTS

- Students are somewhat satisfied with the institution's efforts in promoting internships, student exchange programs, and field trips (48.6%). The mentoring process is seen as moderately effective in supporting their social and emotional growth (46.3%). Opportunities for learning, monitoring efforts (41.9%), and review and quality improvement initiatives (41.0%) are also rated as moderate. Overall, the quality of teaching and learning is considered moderate (48.6%).
- Regarding the teacher, the syllabus was covered, classes were prepared, communication was adequate, fairness in internal evaluation was observed, expected competencies were explained, weaknesses were identified and addressed, participation in extracurricular activities was encouraged, and ICT tools were moderately used.
- The efforts made by the institute and teachers to develop soft skills and prepare you for the professional world are excellent.
- Teachers who identify your strengths and encourage you by providing the right challenges are excellent.
- **Basic amenities** like laboratories, corridors, canteen hygiene, quality of food in the canteen, sports center, gym, and cyber center are satisfactory.
- The feedback highlights the need for improvements in facilities such as the campus, classrooms, toilets, and drinking water, with dissatisfaction rates of 43.5%, 55.6%, 82.5%, and 46.8%, respectively.
- The percentage of respondents giving positive feedback on various **library facilities** is as follows: Library infrastructure (36.5%), availability of books (36.5%), availability of journals/magazines (36.1%), and availability of newspapers (37.4%).
- In the **self-assessment**, students provided very positive feedback, particularly regarding their behavior towards teachers, non-teaching staff, and fellow students.

**Satisfactory:**  $40\% \leq x \leq 40\%$

**High level of improvement:**  $x < 40\%$
