





- Citation format: APA/MLA
- Abstract in about 250 words should include affiliation, email id, full mailing address and 5-6 key words. Plagiarism and AI needs to be below 10% and 20% respectively and report should be uploaded with abstract.
- The registration fee is not refundable if abstract is rejected due to plagiarism.
