
Student Reflections

Exploring the World of Open Source with Hardik Bhatia

One of the most inspiring parts of the session was Hardik's personal journey with GSoC and open source. He shared his experiences, challenges, and lessons learned, motivating students to take their first step.



Hackathon Guidelines

Inter-College Hackathon -

- This is an Inter-College Hackathon Event open for undergraduate participants.
- The hackathon will be conducted in two rounds:
 1. Round 1: PPT Submission + Online Presentation
 2. Round 2: Working Project + Offline Presentation
- The event aims to encourage:
 - Innovation & problem-solving
 - Technical creativity
 - Team collaboration
 - Real-world solution building

Team Size

- Each team must have 2-4 members.
- Teams must nominate one team leader for official communication.

Problem Statements

1. Real-Time Deepfake Integrity Shield

Problem

Advances in generative AI have made real-time audio and video deepfakes increasingly convincing, threatening digital trust and information integrity.

Challenge

Build a real-time detection system for live streams using a hybrid ML approach:

CNNs to detect visual artefacts (e.g., unnatural eye-blinking, facial distortions)

RNNs to identify audio anomalies such as frequency irregularities and lip-sync delays

Twist

The system outputs a Confidence Score and provides explainable insights, highlighting the specific features that triggered the detection.

2. AI Analyst for Startup Due Diligence

Problem

Investors spend significant time manually analyzing pitch decks and financial data, slowing down decision-making.

Challenge

Develop an AI tool where investors upload a pitch deck (PDF) and cap table/financials (CSV). The system performs competitive analysis, calculates Burn Rate and Runway, and generates a structured Startup Scorecard.

Twist

The tool automatically flags Red Flags, such as inconsistent revenue growth, unsustainable burn, or cap table risks.

3. Real-Time Deepfake Authenticity Auditor

Problem

Real-time deepfake video calls pose serious risks of fraud and impersonation.

Challenge

Create a background agent for video conferencing platforms that uses multi-modal AI to detect micro-expression inconsistencies and audio-video synchronization anomalies during live calls.

Twist

The agent delivers a continuously updated Live Trust Score and flags specific moments of suspected synthetic manipulation.

4. AI Travel Planner Agent

Problem

Travel planning is fragmented and becomes stressful when disruptions occur.

Challenge

Build an AI agent that plans trips end-to-end—booking travel, creating itineraries, and monitoring real-time events using LLMs and external APIs.

Twist

The agent dynamically adapts plans in response to delays, cancellations, or user preferences, acting as a proactive personal travel assistant.



Interactive Discussion and Research-Oriented Insights:



