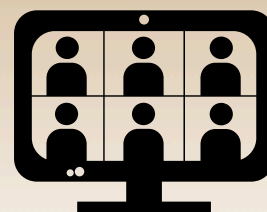

RAMANUJAN COLLEGE

Ramanujan College, a constituent college of the University of Delhi was established in 1958 as an evening college. The College has been accredited Grade “A++” by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in its Second Cycle.

Ramanujan College is felicitated “PRITHVI AWARDS 2024” by ESG Research Foundation in “Global ESG Conference” held on 14th September, 2024 in appreciation of valuable contribution of the College to the Society as Ramanujan college conducts various online courses on ESG Literacy and Sustainability.

Ramanujan College offers sixteen undergraduate programmes in different disciplines. Besides this, the college has been awarded the DDU KAUSHAL (Deen Dayal Upadhyay – Knowledge Acquisition and Upgradation of Skilled Human Abilities and Livelihood) Kendra (2016) by UGC and Teaching Learning Centre (2017) by the Ministry of Education. The College also offers short-term diploma, certificate, and executive development programmes on contemporary and skill-oriented themes to complement the regular graduation courses. It is also the Study Centre of School of Open Learning (SOL), Non-Collegiate Women Education Board (NCWEB) and Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) for various courses.

In 2018, the College conducted a Course on Human Rights, Environment and Ethics through its National Resource Centre (NRC), under the Annual Refresher Programme in Teaching (ARPIT) scheme of MoE. The College has also entered into Memorandum of Understanding(s) with foreign universities. It is also working for collaboration with other higher education institutions located in remote areas of the country, under the Vidya Vistar Scheme of the University of Delhi.



KALINDI COLLEGE

Kalindi College, a constituent women's college of the University of Delhi, was established in 1967. The College has been accredited with an 'A+' Grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in its Second Cycle.

Kalindi College was conferred with the "Best Managed Campus Award" on the occasion of the World Management Congress by the International Association of Educators for World Peace. It also secured top rankings in "Good Academic Practices" at the University of Delhi's Antardhvani mega-events, winning significant cash prizes that have paved the way for a rich culture of undergraduate-level innovation and research within the institution.

The college offers a vast array of undergraduate programmes across Arts, Commerce, and Science disciplines, alongside postgraduate courses like M.A. in political science. In addition to its core curriculum, the college features specialized training modules, skill-oriented add-on courses, and career development workshops—such as its recent Drone Geoinformatics training program conducted in collaboration with the Drone Academy of India. It serves as a major academic anchor in the region, operating active study centres for the School of Open Learning (SOL) and the Non-Collegiate Women's Education Board (NCWEB).

The institution promotes active academic research, executing funded initiatives like the ICSSR Minor Research Projects and hosting structured Summer Research Internship Programmes to foster student-led inquiries. Dedicated to the holistic progression of its faculty and students, the college maintains strong academic linkages for workshops and Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs) aligned with the directives of the Ministry of Education. Furthermore, through active student societies like "Dharohar" (History Society) and its dedicated Sports Utility Centre—housing multi-floor setups for gymnastics, judo, yoga, and table tennis—the college consistently drives comprehensive community development and student enrichment.



CONCEPT NOTE

India's National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) makes a paradigm shift in conceptualizing education as a means to equip students with skills suited for the 21st century and not just for making them employable. It calls for deep rethinking and redesigning of academic systems along with parallel changes in administrative and regulatory systems.
